

OUT OF CLASS EXPERIENCE (OCE) POLICY

SPRING 2026

Students enrolled in fundamentals of engineering courses ENGR 101, 102, 150, 191, ChE102, and MAE102 are required to attend engineering-related events outside of their regularly scheduled class time. These activities, called **Out of Class Experience (OCE)**, are designed to help students develop diverse engineering perspectives, gain a better understanding of the careers available in each of the engineering disciplines, and engage in opportunities unique to Statler College students. OCEs account for **3%** of the course grade in ENGR 101, ENGR 102, ENGR 150 and **5%** of the course grade in ENGR 191. These events can include engineering-related lectures and FEP activities. **The individual Professor/Instructor of each course must answer specific questions.**

CLASS REQUIREMENTS

ALL students (in ENGR 101, 102, 150, 191, ChE102, and MAE102) must complete the following OCEs throughout the semester.
