## AP LATE SALES WINDOW IS NOW CLOSED

Late registration for the 2021 Advanced Placement exams will open **February 15** and close at 11:59 p.m. on **February 26, 2021**. There will be an additional \$40 late fee\* during the late registration window (unless you are enrolled in 2nd semester AP US Government or Macro Economics).

\*Please note: WHS is charged late fees by the College Board and the \$40 fee goes directly to them.

## AP EXAM FEES:

LATE REGISTRATION (February 15 - February 26, 2021): General Students: \$145 - (\$105 exam fee + \$40 late fee) Students who qualify for financial aid: \$80 - (\$40 exam fee + \$40 late fee)

In order to receive the discounted price, BEFORE you make your purchases, upload an electronic copy of your 2020-2021 letter from Nutrition Services confirming your free or reduced lunch eligibility to this <u>Google form</u> (students must be logged into their IUSD Google Account to complete the form). ### Second Semester AP Classes (Econ & Gov't):

Students who are enrolled in AP Economics or Government that starts Spring semester will be registering and paying for exams during the late registration window February 15 - 26. Your teacher will provide a "Join Code" within the first few days of class Spring semester and you will pay for the exam on the web store (\$105) during the late registration window (February 15 - February 26, 2021). You <u>WILL NOT</u> be charged the \$40 late fee for second semester AP classes.

#### **Other Information Regarding Exams**

The College Board has made some changes regarding AP exam registration recently. Please follow these directions starting this school year, you'll need to follow these steps:

#### **Registration:**

Any student that does not attend Woodbridge (including any IVA students) will need to fill out a request form if they wish to take an AP exam at Woodbridge and if we have available space, you will receive an email with further instructions.

#### **AP EXAM REQUEST FORM FOR NON-WHS STUDENTS**

\*\* Please note, this form is only for IUSD students or residence of Irvine. We are not able to register students from other school districts.

To order an exam, currently enrolled Woodbridge & Woodbridge IVA students must:

- 1. Create a College Board Account at <u>collegeboard.org</u> If you already have an account then this step is complete.
- 2. Join your AP teacher's class in My AP (<u>instructions here</u>). Your AP teacher will show you how to do this in class.
  - a. <u>PLEASE NOTE FOR IVA STUDENTS</u>: You will need to get the "Join Code" from the WHS AP Coordinator, the code you receive from your IVA teacher is NOT the correct code for ordering your exam.
- 3. Payments
  - a. <u>Late Registration Window</u> (2/15/21 2/26/21)
    - i. Finally, pay for your exam by visiting the Woodbridge Web Store (HERE). Students will pay for all exams in full from February 15 through 11:59 p.m. on February 26, 2021. The webstore will close on time! (Students that qualify for financial aid - please review information above or see Mrs. Giron in the Activities Office for help, juliegiron@iusd.org).
- 4. Please note, if you wish to take an exam and you are NOT enrolled in the class, you must see Mr. Clarkson in the Media Center before you pay for your exam!

If you are involved in a school event that might conflict with the scheduled Advanced Placement exam or are taking 2 exams on the same date and time, then please see Mr. Clarkson or Mrs. Gorzycki prior to purchasing your exam to discuss the possibility of alternative test dates.
