Room Parents

At Bridlemile we have an active and loyal community of parents and caregivers who are invited to support the teachers and staff with in-class and extra-curricular activities. What is a Room Parent?

Each classroom has 2 parents (3 for Kindergarten classrooms) who make up a Co-Room Parent team. The team's role is to represent and communicate the needs of your child's teacher with parents and (if applicable) volunteers in your class.

You will act as a liaison between the PTA, your teacher, the office and in connection with school activities. You will recruit and coordinate volunteers for in-class help, depending on teacher request and need.

At Curriculum Night, the Room Parent team has the opportunity to introduce themselves and to make sign-ups available for class communications, parent activities and connection and hopefully in-class and extra-curricular volunteer opportunities.

NEW VOLUNTEERS

Before volunteering please go to this link to start the <u>background check process</u>. Read the code of conduct and the mandatory training slides. All adults visiting campus must check in with the office for a volunteer or visitor pass. Once completed, the background check is valid for 3 years.

It can take a few weeks for the background check to be completed, so start the process early! The PPS security office will notify you directly by email when your background check is complete. You can forward your notice to Dana Burling so that she can get you in the system. The first time you come in to volunteer, bring a state issued ID and let them know you need a volunteer badge. Once you are set up, you can check in on the computer inside the office for a badge each time you arrive.

Seasoned Volunteers: Remember that background checks are only good for three years. Please verify with Dana whether you need to renew this year.
