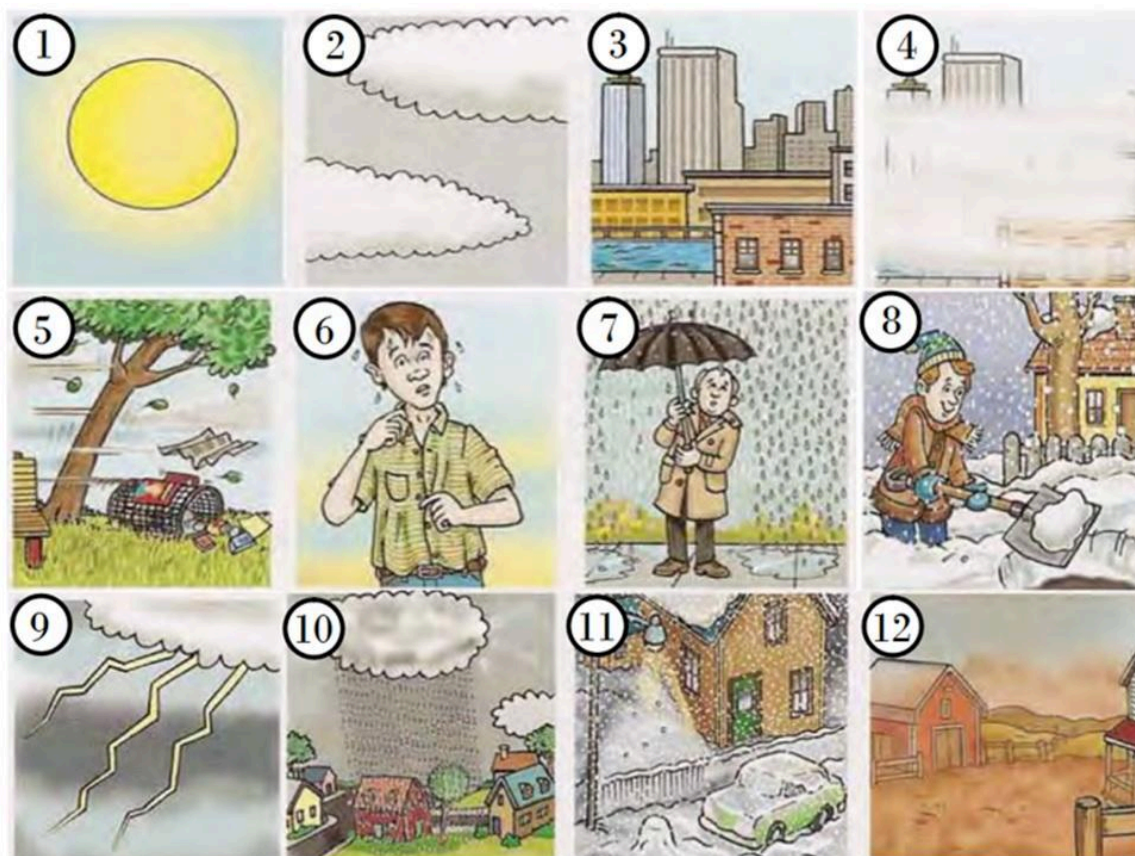


## Talking about the Weather
