Supply ordering

Summer work

5/27-5/28 HQIM work day at ESU 9

We had K-4th teachers and myself attend the High Quality Instructional Materials workshop on May 27th and 28th. We worked to align our reading resource from grade to grade in order to create continuity as students progress from grade to grade. Teachers shared ideas of best practices and planning in order to create a more cohesive program. Teachers also came away from the workshop with a year-long scope and sequence for Into reading and foundations that they will be able to use next year.

6/3 CPI training at ESU 9

I attended CPI (crisis prevention and intervention) training on 6/3. It was a valuable training that worked on de-escalation and ways to help students when they are dysregulated and in crisis situations. We also worked on different deturants and holds in case the verbal de-escalation techniques don't work.

6/9-6/10 Nee evaluation tool training.

Rick and I will be attending the NEE new evaluator training in Wilber on the 9th and 10th. This training will help us become familiar with the new evaluation tool



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as well as help to calibrate how we score teachers in order to make the process more equitable.

6/12 CIP support and guidance day at ESU 9. (8 signed up from our team.)

We have 8 educators going to the CIP day at ESU 9 on the 12th. This will be a time where we can review the recommendations from our external visit and plan for our process moving forward.
