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Stockton Unified School District (SUSD) values educational research and encourages research efforts that foster student learning. While SUSD's Research and Accountability Department reviews all completed applications, only a select number of applications are approved. Applications most likely to be approved are those that are minimally intrusive to SUSD's educational program, do not violate rights to privacy, have instructional and/or educational merit and have strong theoretical foundations.

Research request that may likely be denied are those that:

- Conflict with the vision and mission of SUSD
- Do not benefit the district in informing educational practices, lack educational merit or do not contribute scholarship to the larger educational community
- Compromise the rights of the teachers and students
- Interfere with or interrupt the instructional time

Even if applications meet the minimum criteria for approval, it remains at the discretion of the review committee to deny a research request if the district is unable to accommodate the research due to the volume of research requests applications and/or approved research being conducted.

If a research is approved, it is <u>only</u> valid for the duration specified in the research request and must be carried out in compliance with the original proposed design. Extension of research requires further approval from the review committee and a resubmission of all research request materials. Inclusion of other school sites or departments not in the original design also requires a new application to be submitted. All activities are coordinated through the Research and Accountability Department.

*** A research application is required from all individuals seeking to conduct research or collect data from within the Stockton Unified School District, including internal employees and those not employed by the district.

Submission Deadlines:

2023-2024 application window, a completed and signed application to conduct research in SUSD along with the require forms must be received by the following deadline to be review:

- Fall: November 1, 2023
- Winter/Spring: March 1, 2024

After we receive your completed application, the Research Committee will review your application to ensure compliance with the Protection of Pupil Rights Amendment (PPRA) and the Family Education Rights and Privacy Acts (FERPA). Following the initial review of compliance, applications will be forwarded to associated departments in the district affected by the study; this does not include schools. Even if the research request is approved, it is your responsibility to gain the cooperation of school site principals and other persons. Sites have the right to deny the request and decline participation at any time in the study.

Notification will occur by email; responses from the review committee include approved, approval contingent on additional material submission or denied. Incomplete applications will be denied during the review process.

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EDUCATION CODE, Section 51513:

No test, questionnaire, survey, or examination containing any questions about the pupil's personal beliefs or practices in sex, family life, morality and religion, or any questions about his parents' or guardians' beliefs and practices in sex, family life, morality and religion, shall be administered to any pupil in kindergarten or grade 1 through grade 12, inclusive, unless the parent or guardian of the pupil is notified in writing that such test, questionnaire, survey, or examination is to be administered and the parent and guardian of the pupil gives written permission for the pupil to take such test, questionnaire, survey, or examination.

PUBLIC LAW 103-227 – MARCH 31, 1994 108 STAT.268

SEC. 1017. PROTECTION OF PUPILS. Section 439 of the General Education Provisions Act (20 U.S.C. 1232g) is amended to read as follows:

"PROTECTION OF PUPIL RIGHTS"

- "SEC 439. (a) All instructional materials, including teacher's manuals, films, tapes, or other supplementary material which will be used in connection with any survey, analysis, or evaluation as part of any applicable program shall be available for inspection by the parents or guardians of the children.
- "(b) No student shall be required, as part of any applicable program, to submit to a survey, analysis, or evaluation that reveals information concerning—
 - "(1) political affiliations;
 - "(2) mental and psychological problems potentially embarrassing to the students or his family;
 - "(3) sex behavior and attitudes;
 - "(4) illegal, anti-social, self-incriminating and demanding behavior;
 - "(5) critical appraisals of other individuals with whom respondents have close family relationships;
 - "(6) legally recognized privileged or analogous relationships, such as those of lawyers, physicians, and ministers; or
 - "(7) income (other than that required by law to determine eligibility for participation inn a program or for receiving financial assistance under such program), without the prior consent of the student (if the student is an adult or emancipated minor), or in the case of an unemancipated minor, without prior written consent of the parent.
- "(c) Educational agencies and institutions shall give parents and students effective notice of their rights under this section
- "(d) ENFORCEMENT—The Secretary shall take such action as the Secretary determines appropriate to enforce this section, except that action to terminate assistance provided under an applicable program shall be taken only if the Secretary determines that—
 - "(1) there has been a failure to comply with such section; and
 - "(2) compliance with such section cannot be secured by voluntary means.
- "(e) OFFICE AND REVIEW BOARD—The secretary shall establish or designate an office and review board within the Department of Education to investigate, process, review, and adjudicate violations of the rights established under this section."
