

- If the temperature is below 50 degrees F, you should

wear your jacket or sweatshirt and pants.



- If the temperature is 50 degrees F or higher, it is your

choice!



- In the Fall and Spring when it is wet and muddy,

wear boots.



- If it is snowy, wear the **Winter 5:** jacket, snow pants,

mittens, boots, and hat.



- If no boots, stay on the blacktop or basketball court.



Why? It's for safety reasons and the consistent expectations for ALL students while at school.

Logical Consequences:

If I don't follow 50 degree jacket/ sweatshirt expectation:

1. Write it in my planner to remember a jacket tomorrow. Go to recess.

If I am arguing with a teacher.

1. I will complete a fix-it, family is emailed the fix-it and 50 degree expectation

If I take my jacket/ sweatshirt off outside:

1. An adult will remind me to put it on.
2. I will put it on.
3. If I don't listen, I will do a fix it with that adult.
