SPECIAL PROGRAM
PRESENTATIONS DURING
SCHOOL DAY (STUDENTS
ONLY)

- Certain high schools ask to come present to our students at NVCS. Parents can learn about the programs on the TSD website and at the open houses.
- **L.I.S.A. (Loveland Integrated School of the Arts) Program Presentation:** MVHS Seniors who will be earning their L.I.S.A. Honors Diploma will be at NVCS to present the LISA Program to interested students--Date: Nov. 10, 2025 during WIN class. This is a student-only presentation. (Parents can learn about L.I.S.A. at the 11/12/25 MVHS Open House or on the MVHS website)
 - **LHS I.B. (International Baccalaureate) Programme Presentation**-Date- Nov. 3, 2025 (Parents can learn about I.B. at the 11/5/25 LHS Open House) There is no application for IB; you will sign up for MYP/honors classes. Also make sure you plan to register for a foreign language freshman year since 4 yrs of a language is required.

WANT TO ATTEND A SCHOOL OTHER THAN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD SCHOOL? <u>NOV.3, 2025 -JAN.30, 2026 FOR ROUND 1</u>	GOING TO A SCHOOL OUTSIDE OF YOUR BOUNDARY? 1. Choice Enrollment - If you live inside the TSD Boundaries and you would like to attend a high school outside of your attendance area, you will need to fill out the Choice Enrollment application (even if applying to LISA, STEM etc).Please have your child’s 6 digit ID handy when you apply. (Your child should know this number; they use it at school.) CHOICE ENROLLMENT link - Opens Nov.3, 2025 and CLOSES JAN 30,2026 2. Open Enrollment - If you live outside TSD boundaries you will need to fill out the Open Enrollment application, even if you are currently at NVCS which is a TSD School. This is based on your family’s address, not current school. OPEN ENROLLMENT(link). Application is open starting Nov 3 and goes until May 1st. 3. If you want to attend a high school outside of Thompson School District, please contact that specific high school. FAQ: • Questions about this? You can call TSD: (970)613-6877 • Make sure you are filling out the application for the correct school year. Typically opens sometime in November and closes during Winter Break. • What is my neighborhood school?: TSD Boundaries/ School Locator link • Deadline for Round 1 choice enrollment is Jan 30, 2026. You can apply for a high school after that but Round 1 is recommended so you can register with your classmates and have a plan before May. IF YOU’RE GOING TO ATTEND YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD SCHOOL, THERE’S NOTHING TO DO UNTIL FEBR.!
SPECIAL APPLICATIONS DUE (LISA, STEM...)	If you’re applying for a special program, watch the deadlines for that application process-- Specifically for LISA and STEM. Please check the TSD website for more info.
OPEN/CHOICE ENROLLMENT DECISIONS	‘Choice’ Enrollment (if you live in district)Choice enrollment for the first round closes Jan 30, 2026 for the '26-'27 school year. Notification of Seat Offering, Waitlist, or Denied for 9th grade applications will be in <i>Scribbles Family Dashboard</i> the second week in February. Families will have 5 days to accept their seat. ‘Open’ Enrollment (if you live out of district) notification of Seat Offered, Waitlist, or Denied for 9th grade applications will be in the <i>Scribbles Family Dashboard</i> beginning after the first Friday school day in May. Families will have 5 days to accept their seat. You will not attend registration meetings until your spot has been offered at the specific high school. Some families choose to register at their home district’s neighborhood school as a back-up. If you have questions, call TSD at (970) 613-6877 or their email is choice.enrollment@tsd.org

If you skip this step, we will start the process for your TSD neighborhood school based on the address listed in parent portal for the student's primary household address. MIDDLE SCHOOL TEACHER RECOMMENDATIONS FOR STUDENTS February 2, 2026	NVCS Students will receive course level recommendations from their current middle school teachers (i.e. Honors vs. Regular and which Math & Spanish Course level. Note: Students can take a foreign language other than Spanish if they choose.) Course recommendations for students are also passed onto the High School Counselors by Mrs. Jobman. These recommendations will be handed to students. Students will be responsible for sharing this information with parents when choosing high school classes together.

BHS -Tues., Feb 24, 6:00-7:30 For other schools in TSD--or out of district--please contact them individually. Ferguson now takes freshmen in case anyone is interested. <u>*Please only attend the meeting for the school you have been offered a spot for or if it's your neighborhood school for your address/boundary area.</u> If you are waiting on Choice Enrollment (because you live outside TSD boundaries and want to attend a TSD high school), you will not register during this round. You will register in May or when your seat is offered within TSD.
HS COUNSELOR VISITS & REGISTRATION FORMS DUE (Feb/March)	High school counselors (MVHS, LHS & TVHS) visit NVCS to meet with students after the registration night at the high schools. *BRING YOUR SIGNED REGISTRATION FORM TO YOUR MEETING. MVHS: 1. Wed. Feb. 18, 2026. Students accepted to MVHS will meet with Mr. Smith, Counselor at MVHS, and Mrs. Jobman during the school day. You will get an assigned time. Bring your paper registration form. If you do not have one, we'll have blank forms available. Students waiting on choice/open enrollment may attend if you choose. 2. Wed. Feb. 25, 2026. All students going to MVHS will meet with Mr. Smith (assigned times) to enter courses into the computer and have Mr. Smith check and okay your course requests. You will get an assigned time for this meeting--during school day. LHS: Friday Feb 20. LHS Counselor, Mr. Cain, will be visiting and meeting with students. Please bring your registration form to this meeting during the school day. You will get an invitation for your time. Make sure you have your registration form to turn in on this day. TVHS: March 4th, 2026: TVHS Counselor, Mr Sievers, coming to NVCS . Mrs. Jobman can help you with questions. Forms due that day. BHS: *BHS usually invites students to meet 1:1 with counselors at BHS instead of coming to NVCS. (*You may have to reach out since you're at NVCS and not Turner since they visit Turner about registration)
