Early in the 17th century, a group of religious people called the Pilgrims started to be (1)..... by England's (2)....., because they wanted to change and purify them. As a result, they had to sail to the (3)....., also known as Holland, looking for (4)..... . They spend 12 years in Holland, where they struggled to make a living. After that, they decided to seek a refuge somewhere else – a place where they could create a society that matched their (5)..... .

Eventually, in (6)....., (7).....men, women and children left England on a ship called (8)..... . The voyage was difficult – bad storms

damaged the ship and many passengers thought they wouldn't even (9)..... .

Despite the difficulty, they made it. On (10)....., the Pilgrims landed on the North East Coast of North America. They chose Plymouth to start building their (11)..... because it had an excellent harbour and a large brook in which to catch fish to eat. Although their settlement was finally (12).....in late March, 1621, they dealt with a great sorrow – because of the long and cold winter that year, adding to the fact that they didn't have enough food, nearly (13)..... of their original group died.

In the spring, an (14)..... called Squanto helped the Pilgrims. He taught them how to grow Indian corn and other crops, and he told them which plant were (15)..... and which could be used as medicine. This new knowledge provided an excellent summer harvest for the Pilgrims, and they had enough food for the (16)..... .

As a result, the Pilgrims and the Wampanoag Native Americans became friendly (17)....., and, in the next year, the Pilgrim Governor, William Bradford decided to celebrate with a day of Thanksgiving to God for helping them survive the (18)..... . About (19).....Native Americans were invited to the celebration, which continued for (20)..... .

The colony suffered a (21).....two years later, and the Pilgrims fasted and prayed for an entire day. It is reported that soon afterward it began to rain. They then proclaimed November, 29th a day of thanksgiving to celebrate (22).....to their prayer. This date is believed to be the beginning of the present day Thanksgiving Day, which is held on the (23)..... of November.

The Americans kept doing the thanksgiving (24)..... annually, but it became official after President Abraham Lincoln (1863) made Thanksgiving a national holiday.

Nowadays, Americans of all religions celebrate Thanksgiving. Children do not go to school and most businesses close for (25)..... days. Thanksgiving is a special day for families and people travel great distances to be with their families for this occasion.

It has also become the beginning of the Christmas buying season. Many people today observe the holiday by watching (26), Thanksgiving TV programs, and the (27)..... held in New York City.

For the typical Thanksgiving dinner meal, they have: (28)....., stuffing, mashed potatoes with gravy, sweet potatoes, (28), sweet corn and pumpkin pie. Many families gather and enjoy time together, and give thanks to God for His goodness and faithfulness to them.
