VISITOR ARRIVAL AT VPS FACILITY

- All visiting buses should arrive at their designated area.
- All visitors will be directed by a staff member to their event location.

VISITING TEAM EXPECTATIONS

- Coaches are to act as role models to all students and use appropriate language and behaviors during all events on Vineland Public School grounds.
- Coaches are expected to follow the rules and regulations set by the NJSIAA, CAL, and WJFL. This includes remaining in the designated coaching area and not entering the field/court/mat.
- At no time are visitors allowed to wander around the facility.
- Cheerleaders and sub-varsity players must remain near the visitor stands.
- No one is permitted on the playing field between games, halftimes, or time outs.
- All non-suited players are expected to sit in the immediate vicinity of the coach.

LOCKER ROOMS

- All valuables and personal items must be locked in the lockers or brought out to your bench. Vineland High School is not responsible for the theft of personal items that are not secured. Visitors are responsible for bringing their own locks.
- Locker rooms should be inspected upon arrival. Please alert the athletic director of any concerns.
- Locker rooms should be left in the same condition in which they were found.
- Teams visiting for Boys Basketball, Girls Basketball, and Wrestling will use the Female PE locker room.
- Wrestling will weigh-in at the Athletic Maintenance office.
- Teams visiting for Swimming will use the appropriate locker rooms in the pool facility.

SPECTATOR EXPECTATIONS

- Those who fail to comply with any portion of Vineland Public School's spectator expectations may be subject to removal from the premises and forfeiture of attendance at future contests.
- For security purposes, all spectators will be screened by metal detectors, have their bags checked, and will be wanded by a Vineland Public Schools security guard or a member of the Vineland Police Department.
- No possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages will be tolerated.
- No possession of or use of drugs will be tolerated.
- No smoking on school grounds at any time.
- No posters, banners, or noise makers of any kind are permitted.
- Cheers should be positive in nature.
- All spectators should remain in the stands.
- Anyone who leaves the stadium/building will not be readmitted.
- The ticket booth will close at halftime. Once it is closed, no one is permitted to enter the stadium or building.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Vineland will have a certified athletic trainer available for all athletes.
- Admission will be charged at all Varsity Football, Varsity Basketball, and Varsity Wrestling events.
- All officials, media, etc., must show identification to enter the facility.
- All students must show their school IDs or will not be admitted unless accompanied by an adult.

CROWD CONTROL POLICIES

- Crowd control personnel will be present at every contest.
- Personnel will extend the fullest display of courtesy toward all visiting players, coaching staff, students, and spectators attending games on our campus.
- These trained staff members have the right to remove spectators from our facilities at their discretion.
- Spectators must remain seated in the appropriate designated seating areas during the game.
- Spectators are not permitted to act in a way that prevents another spectator from enjoying the game.
- Noise makers, whistles, posters, air horns, or radios will not be permitted.
- Any spectator showing an outward display of poor sportsmanship, which could possibly lead to a disturbance, will be removed from the campus or turned in to the Vineland Police Department.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

- In case of an emergency, spectators, coaches, officials, and players will be instructed to follow the direction of Vineland Security personnel and the Vineland Police Department. This includes, but may not be limited to, all participants, athletes, coaches, game personnel, and officials.

LIGHTNING PROCEDURES

- In the event of lightning, all spectators should take cover in their vehicles. Visiting teams must shelter in their bus or designated indoor space, which will be provided at the designated location.
