## 2024-2025 New Milford Public Schools Kindergarten Registration Information

New Milford Public Schools invites parents of 2024-2025 incoming kindergarteners to begin the registration process for next school year. Any child who will be 5 years of age on or before **September 1, 2024,** is eligible for enrollment in Kindergarten. For more information on the new Kindergarten age requirement from the State of Connecticut - please visit our website here.

You can begin the registration process by visiting <a href="www.newmilfordps.org">www.newmilfordps.org</a> and clicking on "Student Registration". Click on the school your child would attend (Hill and Plain or Northville) and make sure to be under the 2024-2025 school year. You can check which school your child would attend by clicking on the "<a href="Kindergarten Registration Documents">Kindergarten Registration Documents</a>" and going to the "Boundary Directory."

In order to complete registration:

- 1. Fill out all of the required sections online, which includes:
  - Registration Form
  - Home Language Form
  - Social Development Form
- 2. Provide three proofs of residency:
  - One proof of residency must be a mortgage or lease agreement
  - Other proofs of residency may include:
    - Utility Bills (dated within the last 60 days)
    - Drivers License
    - Car/Vehicle Registration
    - New Milford Tax Bill
    - Certificate of Occupancy
- 3. Provide a birth certificate for the child enrolling.
- 4. Medical paperwork: You and your child's pediatrician will have to complete the physical form. This form as well as a list of required immunizations and other important information from the school nurse's can be found on the Student Registration Page, under "Kindergarten Registration Documents". Your child's pediatrician can fax this form to the school, or you can bring the completed form to the school with your other required documents.

Each school will have two in-person registration days. During this time you must bring all the required documents needed to complete registration (items above). The registration secretary and school nurse will be available to review your registration documents and let you know if your registration is complete, or what steps still need to be completed. The in-person registration dates and times are below:

## **Hill and Plain**

- Tuesday, February 25th, from 10 am -2 pm
- Thursday, February 27th, from 10 am -2 pm

## **Northville**

- Tuesday, February 25th, from 10 am -2 pm
- Thursday, February 27th, from 10 am -2 pm

If you cannot complete the registration documents online, please contact the school your child will be attending for other options including hard copies of the registration documents. Hard copies of the registration documents can also be found at your child's daycare (if in New Milford), or at the New Milford Youth Agency.

## **Mini-K Experience:**

- Students who are registered for kindergarten are also invited to join us for the mini-kindergarten experience that we hold in the spring.
- Once you are registered we will have your contact information and your child's school will reach out to you with dates, times, and specific information regarding the mini-kindergarten experience once the plan for that event is confirmed.
- Registration must be completed to attend the mini-kindergarten experience.
