


## Main Characters



While he's a bit slow to the punch, he just wants to have fun and be included. You may want to lower your expectations if you're expecting a peak performance from him with just about anything, unless he happens to really, really care about what he's doing. His future dreams aren't too broad, and he'd probably end up as some sort of mechanic or handyman.



Arnold Kowalski – A 12 year old kid genius, who loves all things mathematical, scientific, and educational. Always trying to up his academic performance in some way, he strives to go above and beyond within his scientific exploration. While he can be snide and intolerant to the nonsense that sometimes surrounds him, he loves his friends and reaches out at the drop of a hat. He prides himself on his intelligence and likes helping others in various fields such as tutoring or knowledgeable assistance. He hates anything that hinders his hobbies, is a sucker for a good book, and whether he likes it or not, there's a strong chance he'll be included in whatever nonsense his friends drag him into. 
### Secondary and Recurrent Characters

Charles Dingo/ Mr. Dingo – Benny’s friendly and kind of clumsy father. 42 years old. Works as an accountant.


Denise Dingo/ Mrs. Dingo – Benny’s loving and assiduous mother. 39 years old. Works as a photographer and caterer.

Clint Eagle – A conceited, antagonistic Eagle who is seen employed with many varying positions, and can serve as a foil towards the children depending on the situation.




Miss Paula – Benny’s kind and supportive English and Homeroom teacher.




Sophia Valentine – One of Benny’s classmates; A sweet and do-good girl, helping out with different activities around the school, and Benny’s not so secret crush.



Greenville Park – A place for activity and leisure.


Funshine Station – Where the funshine scouts meet.

## Notes

- Set in Present Day
- Plots typically consist of Benny and his friends trying to accomplish some sort of goal or just having fun.
- Cartoon Physics and Slapstick is extensively implemented, but not to the point where things aren't still considered dangerous.
- Episodes are typically a standard 11 minutes.
- Storyboard Driven
- Family/Kids Audience (can have adult humor, albeit more obvious when done). Primarily positive tone, though serious or dramatic moments can still happen.





