Preparation prior to lesson

The teacher writes on the whiteboard the word for each Outside the House sign taught - Backyard, grass, fence, gate, barbeque, shed, letterbox, bucket, hose, garage, lawn mower, garden, trees. - ready for the Clap, Clap Click Game.

5 mins	Set up the video to watch. Students seated on the floor.	
5 mins	Introduction: Introduce the topic - Outside the House  We learnt signs for Around the House (Inside) last year in Term 2.  Today we will learn signs for things outside the house. You will have many of these items at home, outside your house or where you live.  Have fun learning the new signs.	Provided above
	<ul> <li>(Start of Lesson)</li> <li>Read and discuss the Learning Intention and Success Criteria.</li> <li>Check for understanding, clarifying vocabulary as necessary.</li> </ul>	
10 mins	Explicit Teaching: Watch the video	#B Lesson 5 video
	Use teacher discretion to decide if the class needs to watch any part of the video a second time.  Signs taught: Backyard, grass, fence, gate, BBQ shed, letterbox, bucket, hose, garage, Lawn mower, garden, trees.	
5 mins	Explanation of Activity:	
	<ul> <li>Students practise the Outside the House signs together as a class with the teacher.</li> </ul>	
	Clap and Click Game - Outside the House signs     The game starts with students seated in a	
	<ul> <li>circle.</li> <li>Start the rhythm of clapping hands on lap once, clap hands once and click fingers until all get into a group rhythm together.</li> <li>The game continues as the teacher points to an Outside the House word that they've written on the whiteboard. The teacher can demonstrate/model the first one 3 times.</li> </ul>	

	<ul> <li>so the teacher points to 'grass' and the students - clap laps, clap hands and instead of click they do the sign for 'grass'. Repeat this 3 times, e.g. lap, clap, grass.</li> <li>Between changes of signs the students can revert to clap lap, clap hands and click to keep the combined rhythm.</li> <li>Teacher then points to another Outside the House word (for sign taught), e.g. 'fence'.</li> </ul>		
15 mins	Activity:		
	Practise Outside the House signs taught.		
	<ul> <li>The Clap and Click Game - Outside the House signs</li> </ul>		
5 mins	Reflection with Students: (Select for	Reflection with Students: (Select from the following)	
	<ul> <li>Was it easy learning the new signs from Outside the House?</li> <li>Do you have some of these things at your house or where you live?</li> <li>When you go home perhaps you could take a family member outside and teach them the signs.</li> <li>Another good way of improving your Auslan is to combine the item and the colour (as in the video), e.g. red bucket, blue hose.</li> <li>Do you use any of these things at home when helping your family? Share with the class.</li> </ul>
