UPDATE (Thursday 9:30 PM):

After a full day of air, water, and ground search, Chris has still not been found. We thank the volunteers who canvassed Cayuga Lake's perimeter and the many who have shown support by supplying us with food, water, and shelter.

ON FRIDAY May 24th, we will resume the search. (Volunteer coordinator contact info below)

WATER SEARCH

Boats- if you own a boat or know someone who does and are willing to help, please do so but be mindful of law enforcement

Kayakers- please help! kayaks are especially important along the coasts as they can access areas that are not visible to aircraft or motorboats. We would like to send out a group in the early morning if possible although help is more than welcome throughout the day

GROUND SEARCH

Search parties will leave the Schwartz Center in College Town at 10am, 12pm, and 2pm (continuing on at 4pm as necessary). Meet in the gazebo in front of Schwartz, do not part in the bus stop. Please sign up here:

Volunteers will be dispatched from there to the checkpoints on the east side (Milliken Station Rd.http://goo.gl/maps/iK8Jr) and the west side(Sheldrake Point http://goo.gl/maps/nFQRm) of the lake.

Volunteers: Please expect cold rainy conditions; wear close-toe shoes, warm clothing, bring water, snacks, sunblock and appropriate supplies. We will try to have food, water, reflective vests, and

ponchos available throughout the day.

PLEASE VOLUNTEER TO HELP SEARCH

Sign up sheet (rideshare)

- WHO: anyone! Cornell students, Ithaca residents, Seneca/Tompkins county residents, boaters, kayakers, etc.
- WHAT: ground and water search for missing Cornell student Chris Dennis, last seen on Wednesday morning
- WHEN: 8am-8pm Friday, with emphasis on search parties departing Ithaca at 10am, 12pm, 2pm, and 4pm
- WHERE: searches will be dispatched from checkpoints on the East and West shores of Lake Cayuga.
- HOW: sign up on rideshare document. Bring close-toed shoes, warm clothing, water, snacks, sunblock and appropriate supplies.

Search Efforts Summary

- Police have swept both shores of Lake Cayuga with boats (sonar), planes, and on foot every day since Wednesday
- Over 150 volunteers have canvassed most of the lake shore
- "In addition to a large group of Cornell students, the search has involved about 50 personnel from the Seneca County Sheriff's office, Cornell University Police Department, Yates County Sheriff's office, state police, state park police, Romulus Fire rescue and firefighters from Aurora, Seneca Falls, Union Springs and Border City"

Help find missing cornell student! Need volunteers at 8am, May 23rd to search for missing Cornell student Chris Dennis Search party for missing Cornell student

Who: We need as many volunteers as possible

Where: Sheldrake Point (12 miles north of Taughannock Falls, off of RT 89)

When: 8:00am, May 23

Dear friends.

Chris Dennis was last seen at 6am on Tuesday, May 22nd, while camping with friends on Cayuga Lake, at the Johnson property at 890 Lone Retreat Road, Trumansburg, NY north of Taughnack State Park. He asked his friends if they wanted to join him to go canoeing. His friends declined and that was the last sighting of him.

His canoe was discovered overturned 4 miles north of the campsite near the center of the lake. The water temperature is close to 40 degrees, so hypothermia sets in very quickly.

The Seneca County Police along with several other county departments are treating this as a water accident coordinating the search and rescue. They are currently using small boats to check the shore lines. They had an aircraft that is searching as well, but we really need a ground search and need as many volunteers as possible.

This is all we know right now. Please help. Chris is a loved son, brother and member of the Cornell community. Time is of the essence.
