FAQ on DLSZ and AAVA Vehicle Sticker Application/Endorsement

Q: On the appointment system, can you still accommodate walk-ins?

A: No walk-ins shall be entertained. All transactions are strictly by appointment as part of our health and safety protocols.

Q: How do I apply for a DLSZ car sticker? AAVA car sticker?

Q: Do we have a different DLSZ sticker for Vermosa Campus?

A: No, we don't. We have the same DLSZ sticker for both Alabang and Vermosa campuses.

Q: Do we need a Vermosa Estate sticker to access Vermosa Estate?

A: No we don't. Valid DLSZ sticker is treated as a ready access to the Estate.

Q: Do we really need to attend the *Traffic Management Seminar* before we can apply for DLSZ stickers and AAVA sticker endorsement?

A: Yes, especially if we want to familiarize ourselves with the revised campus traffic rules and regulations in this new normal.

Q: What's the *Exit/Lunch Pass* and who can apply for it?

A: *Exit/Lunch Pass* is a consent given to students living within the vicinity of the school (within walking distance) who are allowed by their parents to travel home by carpool or public transportation during dismissal time; or who are allowed by their parents to go home for lunch.

(https://www.dlszobel.edu.ph/wp-content/uploads/2022/07/Exit_Lunch-Pass-form-2022.pdf) has to be emailed or submitted to the Coordinator for Student Affairs and Formation (CSAF) for evaluation and approval before endorsing it to the Safety and Security Office (SSO).

Only students from Grades 5-12 may apply for this.

Q: Does the school allow students to drive their own cars?

A: Yes, but only after complying with the requirements of a *Special Permit* to be reviewed, screened, evaluated by the CSAF before endorsing it to SSO for final interview and approval. This is a very strict privilege to qualified SHS students that only applies to driving in Vermosa campus.

Q: Is carpooling allowed?

A: Per AAVA Bulletin

(https://www.dlszobel.edu.ph/wp-content/uploads/2022/07/SSO_AVA-BULLETIN-ON-S TICKER-APPLICATION_ENDORSEMENTv2.pdf), carpooling is NOT allowed. However, as parents, we can exercise our better judgment to ensure the welfare of our children without compromising the health and safety protocols.

Q: May we accompany/pick up our children to and from their classrooms during drop off and pick up times?

A: Not any more. All parents, guests, drivers, nannies and fetchers are heavily discouraged from entering campus, except for fetchers of Pre-K and K. They shall be allowed to enter gate 7 to proceed directly to the Kinder building entrance gate. There are no more waiting areas for this purpose. Should the cars enter the campus to drop off and pick the kids on designated schedules, only the students are allowed to get off the cars. *One Minute Rule* shall be strictly enforced.

Q: Do parents still need to apply for *Fetchers' ID*? What is the difference between the small and big *Fetchers' ID*?

A: Yes, all fetchers, including parents (if they're the ones fetching their children) must have a Fetcher's ID for added safety on who fetches the kids in school.

Small Fetcher's ID is used if there is only one (1) student to be fetched. Big Fetcher's ID is used for two (2) or more kids to be fetched.

Q: Why can't we get out of our cars to help our kids carry their bags anymore?

A: This is an added health and safety protocol for the students on campus. This limits their exposure to possible transmission of viruses. Hence, the school discourages entry and movements of guests/parents/nannies on campus.
