INTRODUCTION (Goudy Old Style, bold, 12 pt)

The main text format consists of a flat left-right columns on A4 paper (quarto). The margin text from the left 3 cm and top are 2.54 cm, right and bottom are 2.54 cm. The manuscript is written in Microsoft Word, 1.15 space, Goudy Old Style 12 pt and maximum 12 pages, which can be downloaded at the website: <https://jurnal.fkip.unismuh.ac.id/>

A title of article should be the fewest possible words that accurately describe the content of the paper. Indexing and abstracting services depend on the accuracy of the title, extracting from it keywords useful in cross-referencing and computer searching. An improperly titled paper may never reach the audience for which it was intended, so be specific. The Introduction should provide a clear background, a clear statement of the problem.

LITERATURE REVIEW (Goudy Old Style, bold, 12 pt)

The relevant literature on the subject, the proposed approach or solution, and the new value of research, which it is innovation. It should be understandable to

colleagues from a broad range of scientific disciplines. Organization and citation of the bibliography are made in APA style.

The terms in foreign languages are written italic (*italic*). The text should be divided into sections, each with a separate heading consecutively. The section/subsection headings should be typed on a separate line.

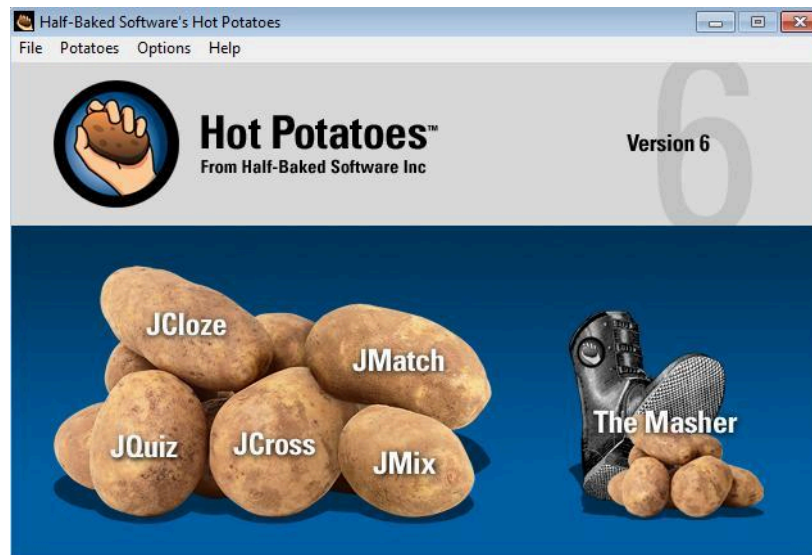

Sub section 1

Equations should be placed at the center of the line and provided consecutively with equation numbers in parentheses flushed to the right margin, as in (1). The use of Microsoft Equation Editor or Math Type is preferred.

The conclusion section must be written in Goudy Old Style, font size 12, 1.15 pt before spacing, and 1.15 pt after spacing.

REFERENCE (Goudy Old Style, bold, 12 pt, uppercase)

Citation and referencing must be written based on APA style 6th Edition which is organized by using Mendeley software's latest version. References used at least 30, 80% primary sources (reputable journals and research reports or community service report) and 10 (ten) years of publication. All references must be tracked online (have DOI or URL).

The references section must be written in Goudy Old Style, font size 12, 1.15 pt before spacing, and 1.15 pt after spacing.
