Seven Sisters Apostolate: Praying for a Priest

The Seven Sisters Apostolate is a way of praying for priests in the offering of one Holy Hour each day of the week. There are seven women that each commit to a different day of the week and offer one Holy Hour on that day for the priest and thus offer a seamless week of Holy Hours for him. This gift is for a year's time, but then may continue on. This is not an exclusive group, and if others learn of these efforts and desire to offer Holy Hours, this will be welcomed.

DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE:

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its <u>policies and procedures</u>, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (bishop, priest, deacon, employee, religious, vendor or volunteer). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to Mrs. Teresa Brown, Complaint Intake Agent, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Brown at 608.791.0179 or intakeagent@diolc.org. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of Safe Environment or on the diocesan website at: <u>diolc.org/safe-environment/reporting</u>. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local Parish and on the <u>diocesan website</u>. If you have any questions about the Diocese of La Crosse and the implementation of the *Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People*, please contact Teresa Brown, Diocese of La Crosse, at 608.791.2679 or tbrown@diolc.org.

<u>NEW</u>: Online training has been updated to include the Diocese of La Crosse code of conduct. Going forward this is part of annual training. The annual verification of protect and healing Form has been updated to include the code of conduct. This form along with the confidential questionnaire must be kept at the parish or school.

<u>REMINDER:</u> Staff and volunteers at parishes and schools must be background checked and trained before they begin working or volunteering.

The FY2025-2026 Parish Balance Tool is now available for download. Use the preceding link to navigate to the parish balance tool folder, where both the FY2024-2025 parish balance tool and the new FY2025-2026 parish balance tool can be found.

NOTE! The FY2025-2026 parish balance tool will only work for those parishes that have completed their FY2024-2025 annual report. The FY2024-2025 annual report is now due on August 31st, except for parishes with a choice school. Both tools are available for downloading.

Use the FY2025-2026 parish balance tool to keep your parish in balance throughout the year. It can be run at any time. The tool is a great way to verify that your parish, cemetery and endowment accounts remain in balance.
