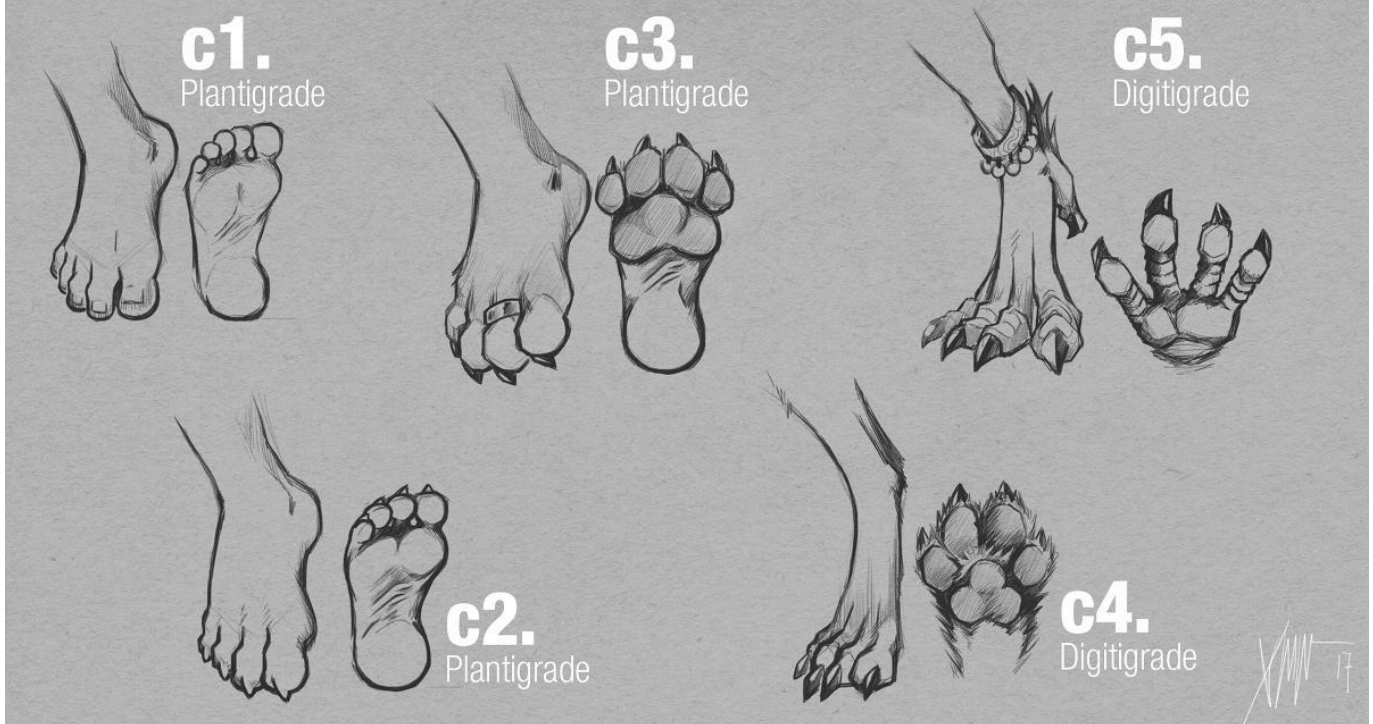

SO! I have a cool surprise for you all tonight! Thanks to ImpXimon's awesome efforts, we have a neato at-a-glance summary of the [Footpaw Classification System](#). I worked with [ImpXimon](#) over the last couple weeks to refine this a bit and make it a really nice and easy chart - check it out:

FOOTPAW CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM

Now - bear in mind this is showing a footpaw that is a good "middle-ground" representation of each of the classes of feet. There is always a little variance in either direction before it crosses into the next paw-type, so.... for example, a C3 at the far end of the scale might look very similar to an entry-level C4, with the difference being plantigrade vs. digitigrade. Anyway, point is that this is a wonderful way to help explain it at a glance to most people! Sera and I had the idea of doing this for like two years, but weren't sure how to go about it.

Now, this supplements the existing document which we'll still keep since it goes into a lot more detail about the types. It's just now a lot simpler to see all at once, at a glance. :) Soooo cool. ImpXimon did such a fantastic job of this - especially given that C3 to C5 are not the sort of foot he usually draws! So go give him a big thank you for us!

TC's Random Music Pick

[The Jackson Five - "Can you Feel It" - 1980](#)

Talk about one of the ultimate "feel good" type songs. :P Sung mainly by Randy and Michael Jackson, it's sorta a weird mix of pop and disco, but very catchy. It also had a very long and epic music video that was made for it called "[The Triumph](#)", which was full of hi-tech special effects (for the time) and was longer than anything anyone had seen before. This was the precursor to some of Michael Jackson's other amazing videos in later years - trial run, perhaps, heh. NOTE: Just because an artist is not marked with "paw-friendly" doesn't mean they don't draw paws - just that I'm not sure if it's a theme they do a lot. I try to use that indicator when the artist is known to draw paws a lot, or has confirmed they don't mind the subject. Also be aware that this is a point-in-time list - it is accurate right of the Paw-Post's release, but may change as slots fill up. Always check!

GENERAL LEGEND

nsfw = Nudity and/or adult situation

nsfw-ish = Impending adult situation, suggestive nudity

sfw-ish = mostly safe, but implied pending adult stuff, or anatomically correct bumps. :P

sfw = hopefully won't damage anyone's brains if they see it on your screen

m = male

f = female

f-h = mostly female hermaphrodite

m-h = mostly male hermaphrodite

h = hermaphrodite (50/50 for m/f)

tm = transgender/inter-sexed, identifies as male

tf = transgender/inter-sexed, identifies as female

gn/u = gender neutral or gender unknown

macro = super-sized characters involved

micro = tiny sized characters involved

reference = character reference sheet

paws-only. = Paws Only; IE, the image is just footpaws/feet

foot-worship = picture denoting worship/love of feet or paws via sniffing, licking, nuzzling, etc.

foot-presentation = picture where the character is purposely showing of their feet to the viewer

foot-tease = similar to above, but where it's more of a playful/purposeful tease at the viewer
TCO! = Tame Comments Only (don't post suggestive or sexual comments on artists page; they don't want/like it)
Light-BDSM = Light bondage type play picture such as basic restraints or shibari
BDSM = more intense bondage, discipline, control, dominance, etc.
human = picture showing a human - in red to stand out for those who don't like human pics!

Some Q&A:

(TC) Hiya Kazu! Welcome to the Paw-Post - glad you could join us, and right after rending so many lovely paws for a bunch of us too. *waves his big feet about* Hurr, so first question - where did you get the idea for your name from? It's so cute. :)

(Kazu) *blushes* Why, thank you! <3 and omg, haha. Though as mentioned in the template, I began to take drawing seriously around 2011 as you've stated, but surprisingly I used to draw much earlier than that, but it was kinda rare and it usually consisted of crappy Pokemon art and other fanart LOL. However, going back to 2011, that was the year when I actually found passion in furry art and just the fandom itself. In 2014, I went digital since I realized I wanted to showcase my artwork online like some of the artists that I was watching during that time. But more importantly, I wanted to become a freelance artist and just be an inspiration to many others, and hope that others might enjoy what I enjoy doing as well. *looks at own paws* *takes a slight deep breath* Though of course, I still have a long ways to go, haha.

(TC) That you enjoy what you're doing is important - I think that helps to keep an artist inspired and interested in what they do, and you do it very well at that! So was furry something you discovered around that time, or did you know about it beforehand?

(Kazu) I agree! haha. And to be quite honest, I really didn't know a WHOLE lot about furies before or during that time! I was mostly interested in feral wolves and "sparkledogs", though that interest eventually led me to anthros/furies! :D

(TC) *blinks* S...sparkledogs? That sounds like what happens if a dog thinks a pack of glitter is a chew toy. Uhhh... so, eventually so you discovered anthros and furies in general - and at what point did the attention on paws start to develop?

(Kazu) I guess you could say that! haha. It was just a term used back in the day that sorta referred to canine characters/sonas with unnatural colors of furs like red, blue, etc.! and of course the discovery of furies was bound to happen at some point! >: Though the point where I *actually* had a passion or even a love for paws kinda came about when I've come across the variety of furry/anthro art on FurAffinity, since well, that was kinda where most of the furry artists were at the time, but also where you would find the more "kinkier" stuff I suppose? xD *wiggles my toes in a cute fashion*

(TC) *whines softly at the cute toes wiggling* Mmmf... well you certainly choice a nice looking version of yourself to have said paws. Alright, so about paws - clearly you're being featured here because you draw some pretty amazing ones. You sorta answered above whether you like paws personally - can you elaborate a bit more on that; what is it you like about them, what types, that sort of thing?

(Kazu) Why, thank you so much! <3 and to answer your question, it can be a bit hard to pinpoint exactly what I love about paws; there's just a lot! :3c But if I were to give you an answer, I'd probably say because paws can be quite adorable/nice to appreciate and draw with the paw pads a.k.a. BEANS, and claws and so forth; and I think we can all agree at some level that paws are infinite times better than just human feet! >: *happily grabs both paws* Regarding all the different types of paws each furry in the fandom have, I pretty much love most of 'em! xD Specially digitigrade and plantigrade. However, I am not particularly a fan of paws that are pretty much exact as human feet with the 5 toes and other similar variations; sorry, haha.

(TC) *grins and watches Kazu grab his feet* Hurr, they are definitely amazing. On our classification system, the more human-like ones are C1 (IE, Class One) feet. They have their charms, but as paws, they do tend to look less interesting than C3s and C4s. Big toes and big plush pads are SO nice. *wiggles his own toes* So it sounds like you have a definite aesthetic attraction to drawing them and enjoying, at the very least - maybe more. ;) What do you find the most challenging about drawing them?

(Kazu) Ohhh, I see! xD and it's honestly pretty neat that you got a classification system for paws! I also wholeheartedly agree with you on that one! <3 Big toes and plushy pads are just the best, haha. *wiggles and splays my toes in agreement* And indeed I do! Though as of right now, I find drawing paws to be easy for the most part, especially the pads, though claw positioning can be sometimes tricky at certain angles. *scratches head* Drawing paws where the toes are either splayed, scrunched, etc., is still something that I honestly need to draw more of since I don't draw a whole lot of it, and in a way I'm a bit ashamed for not doing so, haha xD and that could might as well be a challenge!

(TC) *rumbles happily and stares at your paws* Mmf... I could watch that all day. <3 Yeah, the classification system was born of a way to try and make it easy for someone to tell at a glance if

the foot type would be one they were interested in seeing. Sera and I came up with it a couple years ago. It's ended up being handy for artists too since it makes it pretty easy to ask people what sorta paw they're interested in. Hmm... so I would call splaying an scrunching part of paws being "expressive!" :D Those can be really fun pictures. Do you plan on trying to practice at more of those type of poses?

(Kazu) *blushes from a distance* I see, I see! Well, you both have my thanks, cause as I've said from before, this system can be pretty convenient! xD And yup! I find splaying and scrunching to be 'expressive' just as well, but also playful and rather so damn adorable! <3 And as a matter of fact, I do intend to practice more of these paw poses before this year ends; starting with my own paws! :3c

(TC) Oooo... I certainly look forward to seeing those pictures. :3 Now recently you just did a really fantastic Paw-icon YCH in which you got to do SO many different and awesome looking paw types. First, did you find that a really useful adventure to learn more about them? And is there a particular favourite type of paw you like to draw (which may or may not have been in that effort)?

(Kazu) At the start of doing this Paw Icon YCH, I was honestly only expecting folks with digitigrade paws/pads to purchase them, but that clearly wasn't the case, haha. I've got quite a small variety of paws of different species and types who purchased the YCH, and I can definitely say that it was quite a nice learning experience! In terms of these different paw types other than digitigrade paws that I'm used to, I find plantigrade paws to be my next favorite, haha *looks at your paws and also remembers Sera's*

(TC) *grins and holds up his right footpaw* Mmf, yar - C3s like mine are my favourite. A lot of C3s aren't too different from C4s in the toes and pads - it's the shorter mid-sole and heel that change a bit. Hopefully wasn't too hard a transition for ya. I think they all turned out really good! So can folks expect to see other similar type YCHs from you? And in general, what sort of commissions and YCH do you like offering?

(Kazu) I see! The mid-sole and heel were two of the features that I personally love with plantigrade paws xD And of course not! haha. Trying new things is always something I strive for and will enjoy for the most part! Though thank you anyways! :D And yes! Folks can definitely expect to see more similar paw YCHs in the future that will range from multi-slot icons like previous, but also single slot YCHs and full-body YCHs! Along that, regular commissions will typically open from time to time as per usual. And that's an easy question! Anything pertaining to paws is usually what I like to offer and hope to get from commissioners new and old, haha <3 Though as said previously, I'm willing to try new things as well, given that it's within my interest!

(TC) Hurr, well, you'll find no lack of willing folks on this publication to get more Paw-related commissions. When it comes to art in general though, do you have a favourite theme, style or maybe type of character that you like drawing; as in, one that really gets you into drawing the picture?

(Kazu) Ahh, I'm glad to hear that! *happily gets excited* And to answer that, I honestly don't think I have any specific kind of favorite theme, style, etc., now that I think about it, haha. I'm currently studying and finishing up my last few semesters in graphic design, and once I graduate in the summer of 2019, I do hope to work somewhere, particularly in a game studio or of the sort as an illustrator, while being a part-time freelancer with furry art and commissions on the side! :D

(TC) Very cool! I wish you all the best in completing your studies and pursuing that. And... bit of advice from an old guy; don't be discouraged if it doesn't happen right away. Sometimes it takes a while to finally land a "career" job after graduating. Keep trying, and don't give up on it. :) Now, what other sort of things do you enjoy doing with your free time, outside of art?

(Kazu) Ahh, thanks so much! <3 and I'll definitely keep that in mind! Outside of the realm of art, I honestly don't do a whole lot during the free time other than just browse the web on Twitter, FurAffinity, etc. and shamelessly play a load of video games! xD And even though I'm such an introvert I'll typically go out once in awhile with my siblings or friends!

(TC) Hurr - nice, can't say that's all that different from myself. XD Since doing more work for the fandom, what are some of your favourite things about being fur, or being in this fandom?

(Kazu) Oh man, I have yet to reach half of that, haha. And I agree! :D As for any questions...I don't think I have anything at the top of my head as of right now! *deeply thinking*

(TC) Hurr - don't worry, age will catch up with you soon enough. XD Okay - I have another I just remembered I wanted to ask; you have such a crisp, cheerful style to the way you draw stuff. Was it inspired by a particular artist or.... where did it originate from?

(Kazu) There's no escaping aging sadly. :D When it comes to personal inspiration, it can be a bit hard to pinpoint everything and find out what inspired what, however there have been a few artists that had inspired me tremendously as an artist overall, especially when I was just a starting artist; a few of these artists would be [Citrinelle](#), [AyCee](#), and [KeroTzuki](#)! I've been following them for as long as I can remember, and their art greatly inspired me as an artist! <3

(TC) Hurr, no - but one can do it gracefully and well. :P Ahhh yes - I'm familiar with all three of those artists, very nice (and I've not highlighted any of them yet. :P). I like how you've taken some of their elements of art but very much made it your own style. And it's a style that's constantly improving too - I certainly can't wait to see more of your stuff. Now in closing, is there anything you would like to say to the readers of the Paw-Post and your fans?

(Kazu) Yeah! It's honestly the neatest part of the artistic process—seeing an artist's "style" grow and develop into something that's hopefully original! Though, I'm definitely glad to hear that! :D And there's really not much for me to say other than to stay PAWsome <3 *sticks a peet out*

(TC) *chuckles and sticks one out as well to "give you four" with a tap* :D Thank you so much for joining us again - always wonderful to have such paw-friendly artists, and such a nice one at that. The rest of you readers - go check out Kazutsu's sites! There is so much fun art to see and lots of lovely paws. And you'll definitely wanna watch for the next time he does a YCH (I sure will be). :D
