

How to Share a Google Maps Link to a Location

Sharing a location from Google Maps is easy! Just follow these steps:

1. **Open Google Maps**

On your computer or phone, go to <https://maps.google.com>

2. **Search for the Location**

In the search bar at the top, type the name or address of the place where the event will happen.

Example: *Olbrich Botanical Gardens, Madison WI*

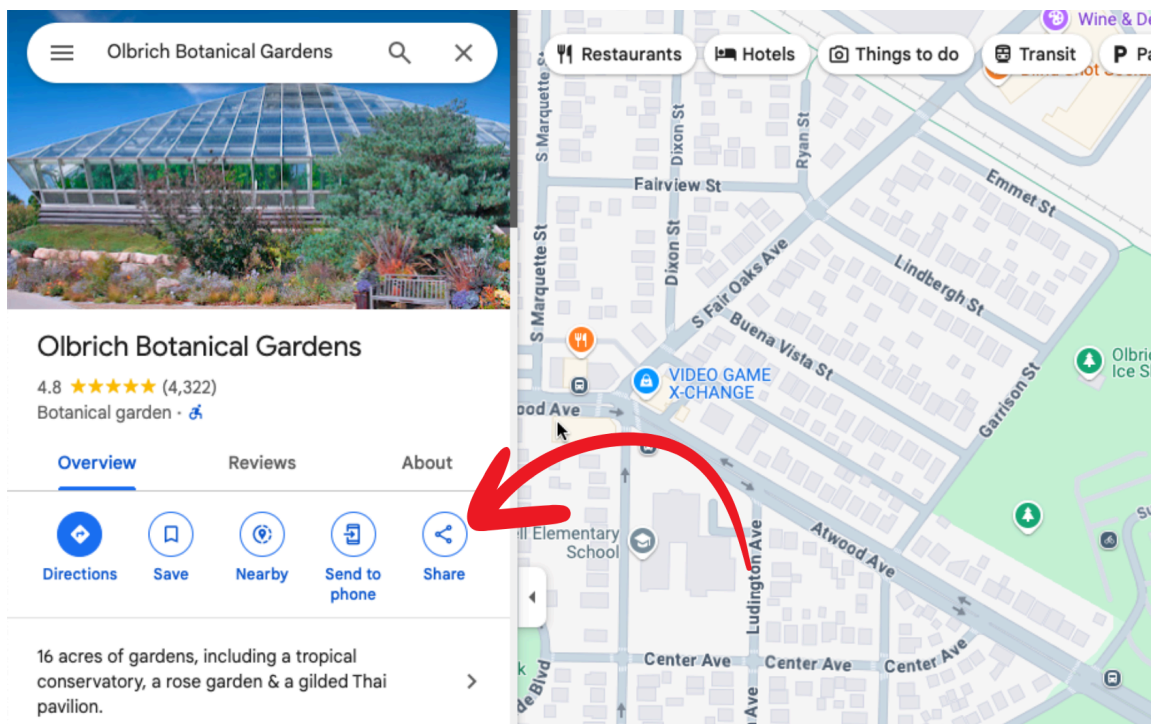
3. **Click on the Location**

When the map finds the place, click on it (or tap it on your phone). A box will pop up with details about the location.

4. **Click the “Share” Button**

On a **computer**, click the "Share" button (it looks like an arrow) in the location box.

On a **phone**, tap the name or address at the bottom, then tap the “Share” icon.



5. **Copy the Link**

- On a **computer**, click “Copy Link.”
- On a **phone**, choose “Copy to clipboard” or select your email/text app.

6. **Paste the Link**

Paste the link into an email, message, or wherever you want to share it with others! Just right-click and select “Paste” (or hold your finger down and tap “Paste” on a phone).
