FADE IN:

SCENE ONE

EXT. - COOP PARK - AFTERNOON

In the wooded area, the foxes are playing in the distance. Birds are chirping in the background and the sun is shining. There are fish in a nearby pond jumping and swimming merrily. Leaves are rustling in the breeze. JONNY appears on screen.

JONNY

While Jonny is narrating, TODD and TED are goofing off in the background. They then smell the cheese and begin sniffing towards it.

CUT TO:

JENNY

(Enthusiastically)

Cheese, cheese, CHEESE! I love cheese oh so much!

JENNY swoops on a piece of cheese and snatches it with her talons. JONNY flies over, noticing her cheese. The foxes see the

two crows and quickly hide behind a tree to eavesdrop on the conversation.

CUT TO:

TODD

(Mischievously)

Bingo! No need to search any further, I think we just found our grub, Ted.

Ted laughs like a henchman. Todd believes Ted laughed too loud and hits him upside the head. Ted scowls at Todd and Todd puts a finger over his mouth to "shoosh" him.

CUT TO:

JONNY

(Curious)

Hey, Jenny! That's a real nice piece of cheese ya got there. Where'd you get it?

Jonny is eyeing up the piece of cheese.

CUT TO:

JENNY

(Aggravated)

Who are you, the cheese police? Find your own!

Jonny begs with his wings.

CUT TO:

JONNY

(Pleading)

Oh come on, Jenny. Don't be like that! Just a small  
bite, please?

Jenny turns away, protecting her piece of cheese.

CUT TO:

JENNY

(Snobbishly)

First come, first served, and it looks like that isn't  
you!

Jonny huffs and flies away to a nearby tree.

CUT TO:

JENNY

(Peacefully)

Finally! Now, where was I?

Jenny goes to take a bite but is interrupted by the foxes down  
below.

CUT TO:

TODD

(Charismatically)

Hey there, pretty bird! What do you  
have in your talons there?

Todd is attempting to blink innocently as he looks up from the  
bottom of the tree.

CUT TO:

JENNY

(Annoyed)

Here? This piece of cheese is ABOUT to  
be my afternoon snack, however, I keep  
getting INTERRUPTED by the likes of  
you.

Jenny looks and holds her cheese with her wing up in their air,  
like a snob.

CUT TO:

TODD

(Agreeing)

We love cheese too! Would you give us a little piece? A nice looking bird like yourself doesn't need the whole slice...

Todd looks at Jenny with puppy dog eyes. Ted was chewing on his leg this whole time, but follows suit.

CUT TO:

JENNY

(Hesitant)

I don't know about all of that-

Todd interrupts her mid-sentence.

CUT TO:

TODD

(Fawningly)

My, my, MY! Do you polish your beak?

It's so shiny that it's almost blinding!

The foxes patiently wait for her response. Jenny blinks incredulously.

CUT TO:

TODD

(Flirtatiously)

Not only do you have a beautiful beak,  
but your feathers are stunning. Did you  
just get them done?

Ted is still puzzled over what Todd is doing.

Jenny starts to giggle.

CUT TO:

JENNY

(Ditzy)

Oh my, do you really think so?

Ted realizes what Todd is doing and plays along.

CUT TO:

TED

(Agreeing)

Oh, yeah, yeah, definitely! Those  
feathers of yours look great.

Ted vigorously nods his head in agreement.

CUT TO:

TODD

(Flirtatiously)

You look like a movie star! Say, can you sing? I heard crows have beautiful voices!

Jenny is blushing and waving her face to cool it off.

CUT TO:

JENNY

Well, I guess my voice is pretty perfect. Would you like to hear my voice?

Ted starts vigorously nodding his head again.

CUT TO:

TED

(Excitedly)

Yeah, yeah, yeah!

Jenny blushes, goes to spread her wings and leaves her perch, but the piece of cheese goes flying from her wing and falls to the ground. Jenny watches the cheese fall.

CUT TO:

TODD

(Arrogantly)

Thank ya very much.

Todd snatches the piece of cheese from the ground. They both snicker to each other and run away. Jenny is in shock.

CUT TO:

JENNY

(trying to process what happened)

I can't believe those sneaky foxes  
stole my cheese!

Jonny returns and notices Jenny has no cheese. He goes to ask what happened.

CUT TO:

JONNY

(Concerned)

Hey now, what's the matter?

Jonny puts his wing around Jenny.

CUT TO:

JENNY

(Sadly)

Those tricky foxes flattered me and I  
dropped my cheese!

Jenny looks like she is about to cry.

CUT TO:

JONNY

(Empathetically)

Oh no! I'm sorry to hear that, but I do  
have a surprise for you.

Jonny removes his wing from around Jenny.

CUT TO:

JENNY

(Curiously)

What is it?

Jonny pulls out another slice of cheese.

CUT TO:

JENNY

A piece of cheese!

Jenny looks at the cheese gleefully and wipes away her tears.

CUT TO:

JONNY

Yes and I will share it with you, but  
remember next time - Somebody who is  
complimenting you may not always be  
your friend.

Jenny nods in agreement.
