At this time, farmers in Punjab, Haryana and later in Western Uttar Pradesh started using modern methods of farming like HYV of seeds, chemical fertilizers, modern implements, irrigation facilities, insecticides and pesticides. These methods enabled the farmers to increase the yield per hectare and their earnings from farming. They, after meeting their needs of food grains, had enough surpluses to sell in the market.
