Notes:

1. There will be both Club and Flight Championships held for the 2026 season.
2. The 2026 Club Championship (CC) will be a stroke play event with the eight lowest gross score players competing in two-round stroke play championship. The eight players with the lowest gross score total for three rounds during the six Championship Qualifier events will compete for the Club Championship. Players must include one score from both the Lakes and the Oaks. After the first round, the 4 lowest scores will go on to the final round to determine the 2026 Club Champion. All eight players must be present during the Club Championship first round which will be played on either August 31 or September 8. The second round of the Club Championship will be played on September 14, September 21 or September 28. If a player agrees to play but doesn't show up will forfeit his participation. If there is a first-place tie after 36 holes the players will continue to play until a winner is determined.
3. The 2026 Flight Championship (FC) will be contested like 2025. Each player must record his 3 lowest net scores from the 6 designated qualifying rounds identified on the schedule to move forward to match play. Players must include a minimum of one score from the Lakes and the Oaks courses. The top 8 players in each of 5 flights (except the eight gross score CC qualifiers) with the lowest total of their 3 net scores will advance to match play. The four match play bracket winners will be the 2026 Flight A, Flight B, Flight C, Flight D and Flight E champions.
4. \*Qualification rounds are marked with an \* and identified in red.
5. Those players not participating in the Championship Play for a given week will play the designated competition listed on the schedule for weekly prize money.
6. Away scramble at Westfields will have individual SUG sign-ups, and the Tournament Directors will make evenly balanced teams.
7. \*\* Note that players 80+ can play any tee they choose but must clearly indicate the tee choice when signing up.
