Who We Are

Middle School Imagineers are a group of students who have applied and have been selected to join the Imagineer program. Imagineer students may be academically focused, but more importantly, they maintain a high standard for the student body. Imagineers show care and concern for the school and the students and staff therein. Their focus is to ensure the continuation of an enjoyable and respectful environment in which students feel that their input is being heard and valued. Each member of the Imaginners will be the lead student for each advisory and will represent their House.

Student Commitment

Members of the Imagineers will be required to uphold a high standard for the student body. Members must adhere to the rules and regulations of IC Imagine. Membership will be revoked for any student that displays a pattern of misbehavior, poor attitude, or who receives more than 2 major office referrals.

What We Do

- *Act as a liaison between the students, teachers, and administration.*
Students meet with the Middle School administration monthly to give feedback about how school is going and what can be improved, as well as plan/ provide input for upcoming events. This partnership serves to ensure that the students are represented in the decisions made by Middle School administration.
- *Act as ambassadors for Middle School*
Imagineers act as student representation for on-campus events that promote the school during enrollment season.
- *Help facilitate PBIS*
Students work closely with the Middle School PBIS coordinators, Administration, and Counselors to plan and implement PBIS events and prizes, as well as provide feedback about things that can be improved at school.
- *Participate in Community Service Opportunities and Help with IC Imagine Events* Examples: Make posters for school events, Canned Food Drive, Help with Band Concerts or other events.

 - * Applications must be submitted using each student's IC Imagine email
 - * The application involves writing. We encourage students to brainstorm with parents, teachers, or other trusted adults ahead of completing their application. It is always okay to use voice to text, google read and write and other tools for support in completing the application
- After each student applies, we will ask their Advisory teacher to complete a teacher recommendation form
- Application responses and the teacher recommendation forms will be reviewed by the selection committee
