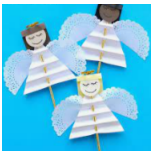
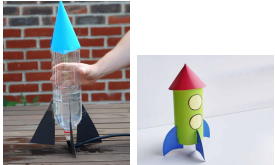


Fox & Chamber Class Mission Homework – Autumn B 2025

Your target up to half term is to earn a minimum of 100 points by selecting homework tasks from those below. You can choose to do any of these tasks, to meet or exceed the total points. The focus is quality work (**not just completing work**). All homework needs to be completed before the end of the half-term. Think carefully about the presentation and content of your work to **make sure you give your best** to produce work to be proud of.

History Oldham is famous for the cotton industry and its mills. L S Lowry was a famous artist who painted pictures of the mills. All of our classes are named after famous mills in Oldham. Can you research mills in our local area? Can you find Chamber or Fox mill? Sketch or draw a mill using as much detail as you can and write a few sentences about it. You can use pencil or paints to do this. 30 marks	Religious Education Angels are often used in the Bible to recount the bringing of Good News to Earth from God. Create your own angel by drawing, painting or even making your own angel with lots of detail and decoration. Here is just one idea using everyday items to get you started!  30 marks	Science Can you design and test a rocket flight path? Katherine Johnson helped NASA calculate rocket flight paths to send astronauts safely into space. Your challenge: make and test a rocket!  40 marks
History Oldham has many statues and monuments commemorating famous historical events and people. Can you research some of these? You could draw or even make a model of one of these monuments.  30 marks	Religious Education As we will be learning all about Mary and Joseph's journey to Bethlehem in the lead up to Jesus' birth, can you design a Christmas card which shows this journey? Remember to include Mary, Joseph and the donkey.  30 marks	Science Can you be a weather scientist and study winter changes? Scientists look for patterns in the weather and how the seasons change. For one week, look outside at the same time each day. Draw or write what you see — is it sunny, cloudy, raining, or frosty? What are the trees and plants like? What clothes do you wear? Can you spot any changes through the week? In your learning journal, draw or write: Your daily weather observations How winter looks and feels. 30 marks
Art Go on an autumn walk and collect a few different leaves. Choose your favourite and draw it carefully, looking closely at the colours and patterns. Try mixing two primary colours to make autumn shades for your artwork. 	PSHE - valuing differences In PSHE we will be thinking about our similarities and differences and what makes us special. Do you have a special talent or something you are really good at? Take a photo or draw a picture of you doing the activity that you are good at and stick it in your homework journal. Could you label it and add a sentence or two? eg. <i>'I am really good at _____.'</i>
