

Terms of Service

These terms were created due to issues that some of my fellow artists have dealt with. This is not because of something you personally did, but to protect myself and my artwork. Please read these carefully as you will have to agree to these before I start on your piece.

Summary

- Please do not ask me personal questions. This is simply a transactional situation.
- Do not make any sexual or romantic advances towards me or tell me what you plan to do sexually with a piece.
- Please send all references, ideas, etc. before I start.
- PLEASE PROVIDE SOME FORM OF REFERENCE TO WORK WITH. If you have never commissioned the character before/ haven't drawn them, a character creator image will work just fine.
- If I am doing a custom, please give a thorough description. References will also help.
- I will provide WIPs as I go along. If you wish to make any changes at these points, please tell me. After the piece is finished, you must pay a fee to change anything else.
- Refunds can be given if I have not started your piece. After the sketch process is completed, you will only get a half refund. Completed or near completed pieces are non refundable.
- You do not have my permission to use my art for t-shirts, mugs, etc, unless it is agreed upon during the commission process
- You cannot use my art to make money for yourself [tracing the art for commissions you sell, turning it into a YCH, etc]
- Do not recolor, trace, or heavily reference my art unless stated otherwise. [You may post, use and share the commission as long as I am credited]
- Do not remove my watermark from the piece.
- If you buy a custom, adopt, or redesign you are not allowed to resell them for more than you paid without adding art to them. If you get a free character/custom, you are not allowed to trade, sell, or gift them until 2 months after receiving them. You may change the design as much as you like as long as you don't sell the original piece. If you do change the character, either delete the original piece or keep it. Password is: [Yes, I understand and agree to the TOS]
- I have the right to decline any commission I see fit. If I do not have the time, the skill or am uncomfortable with the request, I will say no.
- I will not trace another artist's work unless given permission from the artist who created the piece. However, I will not copy it directly.
- This list is subject to change as time goes on.

Respect & Boundaries

When I discuss a commission with a customer, I do my best to be polite and kind, and I very much expect that in return.

Please do not:

- Complain about slow response time to your messages, the queue or the artwork
- Be disrespectful to me or others during the process

Now, I do draw NSFW work for people, but that does not mean I am interested in romantic or sexual encounters with my customers. I am in a committed relationship and do not wish to hook up with you. Talking about....pleasuring yourself to my artwork is not something I need to be told. You can very much keep that information to yourself.

Please do not:

- Attempt to flirt with me or try to initiate smut roleplay with me
- Make suggestive comments about the artwork, me or the character as I work on it [unless you are simply complimenting the work]
- Tell me that you plan to pleasure yourself to the piece

Initiating conversation with someone to commission them can be very awkward. Sometimes you want to try to be friends with that person. However, that isn't always the case, so please respect my boundaries about my personal life. I don't mind having a chat with you, but please keep it relevant. It is important to get to know who will be drawing for you, but-

Please do not:

- Ask me where I live
- Ask me about my personal life
- Ask me my real name, my fiancé's name, etc.
- Send me pictures of yourself [unless you ask first]

Asking me about my opinion on your character, the piece, or opinions on the fandom your character is from is perfectly fine subjects to discuss.

References & Editing

If you wish to change anything about your character, please let me know before I start on the piece. I am not psychic so I don't know what things you want me to change if you don't tell me about it.

- If you are sending me an image as a reference, be sure that image is correct.
- Please do not send me unfinished artworks for references.

I will not accept sketches or black and white references unless we have both agreed upon it.

“Why?”

If I color pick something from an image that is incorrect, I will need to go back and fix it. Or if the image does not have color and you send me a color palette it may not turn out the way you thought it would and it would need to be changed.

Again, if you have any reference images, ideas, or artworks, supply them before I begin or tell me and let me know, as if I finish a piece and there needs to be a change, I will have to draw over the piece. I like to flatten my drawings after I'm done and my art program will not allow me to unflatten. This means the new edit will look wrong and not fit into place. So please inform me of any changes before I finish the piece.

I understand that sometimes people forget something and will tell me as soon as they remember. That's okay, mistakes happen. My only issue is if it happens again and again and again, either in the same art piece or if you choose to commission me again. Needless to say, it's very annoying.

Rule: I will supply multiple WIPs throughout the process. You will get free edits during this time, however, if you have an issue with an earlier process while I'm working on a later stage, there will be a small charge.

Each edit will cost 2\$ to fix between 4-6 edits
Anything more is 5\$ ea.

Permissions & Refunds

Sketch/Idea phase	Full refund
Linework + coloring	Half refund
Completed artwork	No refund

This is because, if i finish the drawing I have already spent my time completing it and therefore completed my job and my half.

Piggybacking off my work is not allowed. This means, if you buy a commission from me you cannot use it to make a base, trace, heavily reference, sell merch of, or make money off that commission in any way. The only time I see this as acceptable is if you are genuinely selling the character to get rid of them.

If you buy a custom, redesign, adopt, or oc from me you are not allowed to sell them for more money without adding to them first. This means, you must buy, create, or supply drawings of that character first. If you buy a character for 50\$ and they have one artwork you cannot sell that character and it's one artwork for 80\$. Add to its worth in some way or another before you sell them.

If you get a free character as a prize or gift you are not allowed to sell them at all until you add to the character. If you have to get rid of them it would have to be either a gift, trade, or for free as you did not pay for the character in the first place. If they have other artwork than the free drawing you may sell them based on worth.

If you get a character from me that I created you are not allowed to sell/trade/gift them until 2 months have passed. Please give them a chance, you can always ask me if i can change something to help you like them better.

If you have any questions please let me know.

General

I am allowed to decline any commission I see fit. If I am uncomfortable, too busy, or have a full queue, I do not have to accept your commission.

I **will not** trace any other artist's artwork unless I am given permission from that artist to do so. Even then, I will still change something so that it's still unique.

- This includes other artist's commissions, YCHs, or P2U bases.
- F2U bases are fine as long as I know the artist's name so I can credit them properly

Do not remove my watermark! It is there for a reason. At this point I haven't had issues with my personal watermark, but if I have to start heavily watermarking my art, I will.
