Being a part of a theatrical production is a wonderful opportunity to perform as an ensemble, to develop skills in acting, singing, dancing, public speaking and, of course, to have some fun! Joining an after-school musical theatre production can also:

- Form new friendships
- Build self-confidence
- Develop the imagination and creative thinking
- Sharpen concentration, critical thinking, & problem-solving skills during scene rehearsals
- Strengthen memory & self-discipline memorizing songs, lines & rehearsing scenes



Commitment

Our main goal is for students to enjoy the process, but please consider that joining the musical is also a serious commitment. It requires a great deal of time, effort, and focus to prepare for a production. Students will be expected to come to rehearsals on time and ready to learn with their script and a pencil. Directors will set clear goals for memorization of lines, lyrics, dance moves, and blocking that may require practice at home for some students. Students must take responsibility for keeping focus during rehearsals and preparing their parts the best that they can to support their fellow cast members and overall progress of the show.

The musical is a longer and larger commitment than a simple enrichment class. We typically rehearse up to 3 days a week for an hour after school in January & February and two hours or more each rehearsal in March & April. (**NOTE**: Most characters will not be requested at every rehearsal).

Workshops & Auditions - all students who audition will receive a role in the show.

Prior to auditions, we will hold workshops for all interested 4th & 5th grade students to get to know some music, scenes, and dances from the show. This is a great opportunity to see what participation in the musical will be like. *All interested students are encouraged to attend!* Students who attend the workshops do <u>NOT</u> need to audition for the show should they change their minds.

Musical Fee

Students participating in the musical will pay a \$65.00 enrollment fee (made payable to District 73.5 - to be brought in <u>after</u> they have accepted their assigned role) to cover the cost of their script, musical royalties, sets, props, and <u>some</u> costume items. Most students will be asked to provide their own socks and shoes, and some roles will also provide a basic black base (black pants and shirt).
