Keep this as a resource to access online applications. If it is not listed in this booklet with a website, it is likely that a paper application will be required.

If you are asking people for a letter of recommendation, make sure you give them a week or two. Give them a resume or brag sheet. Do not use family members.

Unofficial transcripts can be found on your Skyward account under the portfolio tab (be sure to preview your transcript so your self-reporting is consistent with the ranking and cumulative GPA being sent out on your transcript). If the scholarship requires an official transcript, please [request](#) it online or see [Ms. Apfelbeck](#) with questions.

Ask the financial aid office of the school you are applying to, and search the college website. Most colleges require you to be accepted to them before applying for scholarships.

Never pay a fee or any money when applying for scholarships. Scholarships are meant to be free. Be *Wary* of giving out your Social Security information for a scholarship application.

There are scholarships that we may not be aware of. Other places and ideas for seeking scholarship information: parents' employers, and membership in clubs, churches, and co-ops. Watch for postings in stores, community bulletin boards, and search on free scholarship websites,
