

## Rally/protest Code of Conduct

⚠️ Please read in advance of event

🚒 We will have designated event marshals in case anyone has any safety or medical concerns. They will be identified in the beginning of the rally and will be wearing reflective arm band or safety vest. Please be respectful and listen to any instructions given by the event marshals.

📄 Please hold/carry all signs and banners. Signs may not be pierced into the ground or affixed to any fixtures, statues, or buildings on the property. “The use of any props or other items that pierce/damage the legislative precinct grounds is prohibited. Props brought onto the grounds as part of a demonstration may not be used to cause injury or harm.”

🚫🏛️ We may not enter the Legislative Assembly of Ontario building.

🚫📷 Photography on the steps leading into the entrance of the Legislative Assembly of Ontario is prohibited. “Photos on the grounds are permitted, provided they are for non-partisan and non-commercial purposes, and they do not interfere with the business of the Assembly. Photography on exterior stairways is restricted and requires prior approval.”

🚫💰 Solicitation of donations or selling items is strictly prohibited. “The sale of any items or services, or the solicitation of donations for any purpose is strictly prohibited unless authorized by the Speaker.”

🚫🚬 Smoking is prohibited.

🚫🎈 Balloons are prohibited.

🚻 Nearest washrooms are at Tim Hortons at College St & University Av (southwest corner).

🚗 There is no parking available on the Queen’s Park/OLA property. There are several public parking lots nearby as well as some streets nearby that have street parking availability. “All unauthorized vehicles will be tagged and towed at the owner’s expense. No vehicles are allowed on the legislative precinct lawn without prior written authorization.”

📰 This rally is to gain the attention from media and for public support in order to put pressure on the MNR for answers as soon as possible. A press release has been sent out to media outlets for this rally.

✌️ This is a peaceful demonstration. We will be utilizing our rights and following the law. Please do not use inappropriate or profane language. Please do not engage with negative comments or remarks. Please always remain peaceful, calm, and non-violent. Please respect personal space. Stay on-topic, we are here for the raccoons and all other wildlife.
