Bay Area Arts Worker Relief Fund

A financial resource for workers in the visual, literary, media, film, and video arts negatively impacted by COVID-19. The Fund aims to prioritize Bay Area art workers in the BIPOC communities (Black, Indigenous, Person of Color); disability community/immuno-compromised; and, LGBTQIA+ communities.

California Relief Fund for Artists & Cultural Practitioners
 \$1000 in unrestricted, rapid relief funding to individual artists and cultural practitioners statewide. Submit applications by August 18th, 3pm, PDT.

Theater Bay Area Fund

Theatre Bay Area, in partnership with Dancers' Group and InterMusic SF, launched the *COVID-19: Performing Arts Worker Relief Fund* on March 20, 2020, as a resource for performing arts workers who are facing a loss of income due to the ongoing COVID-19 crisis. One-time \$500, \$1000, \$1500 grants for performing arts workers, including actors, administrators, box office/event staff, carpenters, dancers, designers, directors, dramaturgs, musicians, playwrights, production staff, singers, teaching artists, technicians, etc. Rolling deadline. <u>Donate here</u>

Artist Relief

To support artists during the COVID-19 crisis, a coalition of national arts grantmakers have come together to create an emergency initiative to offer financial and informational resources to artists across the United States. Artist Relief will distribute \$5,000 grants to artists facing dire financial emergencies due to COVID-19. Cycle V application closes **August 26, 11:59**, ET. <u>Donate here</u>.

• So Love Can Win Rapid Response Fund

Rapid response grants of up to \$10,000 for Oakland 501c3's and fiscally sponsored racial justice-centered entities/projects led by Black, Indigenous, people of color and that demonstrate a history of work with Black, Indigenous, people of color in Oakland. Organizers, cultural workers, healing justice advocates, and journalists eligible to apply. Applications available online, or apply by scheduling a phone call with program staff.

- Foundation for Contemporary Arts COVID-19 Relief Fund

 NATIONAL One-time \$1,000 grants to artists who have had performances or exhibitions canceled or postponed because of the COVID-19 virus. Ends December 1, 2020.
- Arts and Culture Leaders of Color Emergency Fund
 \$200 grants for BIPOC (Black, Indigenous, People of Color) artists and administrators (consultants, facilitators, box office staff, seasonal/temporary employees, etc.) who have been financially impacted due to COVID-19. <u>Donate Here</u>

• Queer Writers of Color Relief Fund

\$100 - \$500 grants for queer writers of color.

• CERF+ Emergency Assistance Inquiry

For artists who experienced a recent, career-threatening emergency, such as an illness, accident, fire, or natural disaster.

• COVID-19 Financial Solidarity

Opportunity to request and offer direct financial assistance and other support, to folks in need around the country.
