We would like to offer your child the opportunity to join the after school Homework Club at Roland Hayes. The Homework Club will be available Monday and Thursdays afternoons, from 2:30 – 3:30, beginning September 28, 2026 and is offered to children in grades 4-8.

Please note: *Homework Club does not meet on Early Release days or inclement weather days.*

The purpose of our Homework Club is to provide a supportive, focused, and quiet setting in which a student can complete homework assignments, discuss homework with an adult, and plan ahead for upcoming assignments and projects.

In order to maintain an appropriate study and learning environment, there are several student expectations:

HOMEWORK CLUB: Mondays and Thursdays, 2:30 – 3:30 PM

- Each student will be expected to:
 - bring all of their needed supplies including textbooks, paper, pencils, homework folder, ChromeBook, and assignment notebook or agenda
 - demonstrate to the Homework Club teacher what they are working on and/or show that they have completed all assignments
 - have a personal reading book should their homework be completed before 3:30 pm (they will not be allowed to return to their classrooms for any items)
- Attendance is an important indicator of student commitment and will be each session. Families will be called if a student does not show up to Homework Club. Please call the main office at (617) 879-4570 for any planned absences.
- Students are expected to remain the entire hour. Early dismissals create unnecessary disruptions to other students.
- Inappropriate behavior that disrupts the learning of other students will result in initial parental contact and removal from the program for a second offense.
- Dismissal will be through the front doors on Eliot St.
- Snacks are not permitted.

Homework Club Rules and Expectations

1. When students come into the classroom, they are to find a seat and begin working immediately.
 2. Students are expected to be responsible, independent, and focused workers.
 3. Students should raise their hand if they have a question, but continue working at the same time, until the teacher gets to them.
 4. Focus and work hard for the entire hour!
 5. If a student finishes all of their homework, they must read a book, write, or review homework.
 6. Please keep in mind that some students may not finish all of their homework during Homework Club.
 7. No cellphones use is permitted.

For Students: Homework Club Procedures

- ☐ Students are to walk into the classroom quietly.
- ☐ Students will report to their assigned seat and room
- ☐ Unpack all homework items, including folder and agenda.
- ☐ Have 2 sharpened pencils, pens and ALL necessary books ready.
- ☐ Go to the bathroom and get a drink (this will be the only time you are allowed to leave the classroom before 3:30).
- ☐ Begin your homework assignment on your own.
- ☐ Raise your hand if you need help.
