- **Elementary ICAP**
 - Teachers establish practices that support students in identifying personal strengths, goals, and actions. These are revisited throughout the school year.

 - **1st/2nd Grade:** Teachers record in Infinite Campus Homeroom using 'Able to identify strategies for setting goals' dropdown ([Helpsheet Grades 1-2](#))
 - **3-5 Grade:** Students complete Google surveys and results are shared with teachers by the College & Career Success Department. Teachers record in Infinite Campus Homeroom using 'Exploring individual strengths, motivations, and challenges' and 'Demonstrating academic plans and future goals' dropdowns ([Helpsheet Grades 3-5](#))
 - Students should be provided time to incorporate this learning into their digital portfolios.
- **Middle School ICAP**
 - Schools coordinate with Graduation Coaches to map out [ICAP processes](#) and supports needed for the 5 ICAP themes +Game Plan surveys ([GP survey lesson example](#))
 - Graduation Coaches, College & Career Center Advisors, and DU Interns can support schools in ICAP activities that are off campus (Young Ameritowne, Finance Park, Career Trek)
 - 7th Grade: Students complete the Cluster Finder
 - 8th Grade: Students complete the Career Key

- **High school ICAP**
 - Schools coordinate with Graduation Coaches to map out [ICAP processes](#) and supports needed for the 5 ICAP themes +Game Plan surveys
 - Strengths Explorer is optional and can happen at any point as a Self Discovery lesson.
 - Coordinator of Counseling Services supports Mental Health teams in reviewing Game Plan and other student data to determine programming needs. This work is also connected to DDI and counseling best practices.

- College & Career Center Advisors work with counseling teams to coordinate supports for seniors in taking steps that launch their postsecondary plans (college applications, military enlistments, career applications)
