Subcommittee on Writing (WS) (2 year term, see 12-13 CIC 4) Membership: Director of Composition, Director of the Student Center for Academic Achievement, Director of Writing Across the Curriculum, 1 faculty with experience in teaching English to speakers of other languages multilingualism or related field, 1 CLASS outside ENGL, 1 CBE, 1 CSCI, 1 CEAS, faculty Director of General Education, a lecturer faculty if no other member of the subcommittee is a lecturer; and a faculty member of CIC, if no other member of the subcommittee is a member of CIC. The subcommittee should vote on a Chair prior to the start of a new academic year. The new chair will convene the meetings. Though members are subject to annual appointment by the Chair, in consultation with the whole Committee and subject to the approval of the Executive Committee, the expectation will be that each member will normally serve for 2 years. Meetings occur every other Monday alternating with CIC from 2-3:30 pm.
