The first business I went to was a pest control service. At this time, they're trying to recruit a bunch of people, and I can see that they are nowhere near poor. One of their guys just bought a McLaren, apparently. So I saw this as a pot of gold. I don't know if the answer is yes, but we did end up exchanging phone numbers, so I think this is a good sign. The guy seemed pretty interested.

The second one was a barbershop I used to go to when I was younger. We had a pretty friendly conversation, but the man said he's retiring soon, so I completely understand why he doesn't really need me.

The third guy I spoke to is a brick mason, and he does work pretty much all around the city. I happened to see his truck as he was coming out and it had the name of his business. I thought this was cool because my dad also lays bricks. We spoke for a bit, and he handed me his business card. I texted the number, but I have not gotten a response yet.

This really was not that bad at all. It's not as scary as some might think. It actually boosted my confidence and I know I'm gonna end up doing this some more.
