# 1. Transportation from the Incheon International Airport to Ewha Womans Univ

## A. Airport Limousine (Bus)

- Bus number: 6002 (Direction: Incheon Airport → Ewha Womans Univ. Station)
- Fares: approx. 17,000 KRW (Ticket purchase required at the airport terminal)

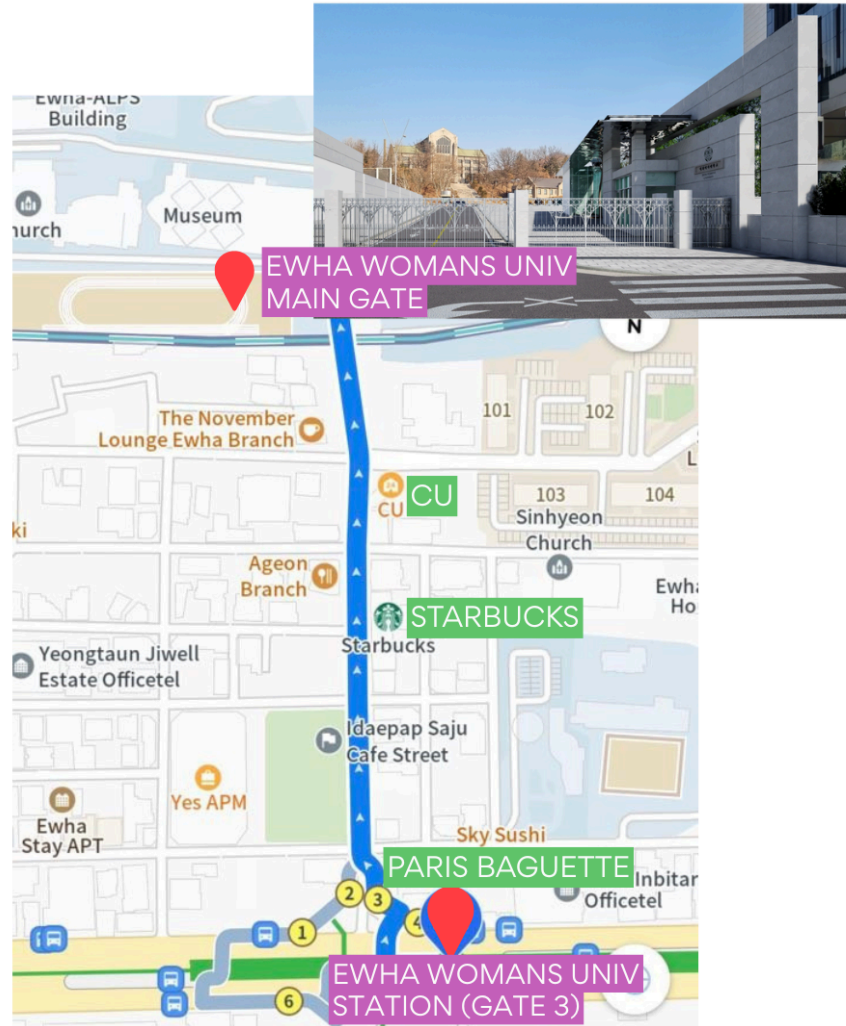

1. Exit **Ewha Womans Univ. Station** via **EXIT 3**
2. Walk straight for approximately 200m toward **the Main Gate of Ewha Womans University** (**Paris Baguette, Starbucks, and CU** will be on your right)

& Longview House (Korean Women's Institute)>

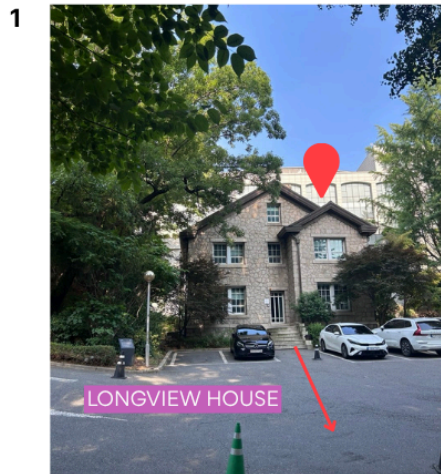


- **To ECC (Ewha Campus Complex)**
  1. Enter through **Ewha Womans University Main Gate**.
  2. Walk straight up the main campus road.
  3. Continue along the road until you see **ECC** on your left.
  4. Enter **ECC** from the main entrance (**Gate 3 and 4**) area.
  
- **To Yeonghak-gwan (Asian Center for Women's Studies) & Longview House (Korean Women's Institute)**
  1. Enter through **Ewha Womans University Main Gate**.
  2. Walk straight up the main campus road and pass **ECC** on your left.
  3. Continue walking uphill toward **Admission Hall**.
  4. Keep walking past **the Physical Education Building** and **the Arts & Design Building**.
  5. Continue along the road until you reach **the Yeonghak-gwan & Longview House**.

Exit **Longview House** and walk straight along the path.



As you walk, you will see the **Central Library** on your right. Follow through the arrow.



Continue walking until you reach **Yeonghak-gwan**. From here, please follow the **Yeonghak-gwan to ECC directions**.

1 Exit **Yeonghak-gwan** and follow the direction of the arrow.



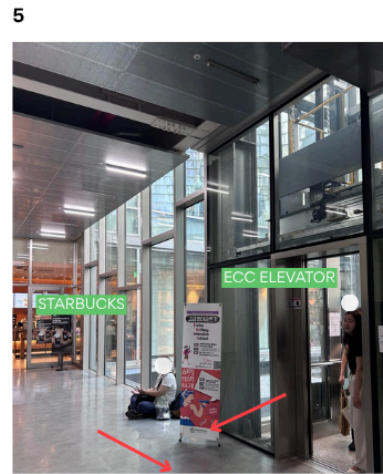
2 Walk down **the stairs**.



3 Once you reach the bottom of the stairs, you will see the **crosswalk** shown in the photo. Cross the street and continue straight toward **ECC**.



4 Follow the direction of the arrow, then take the elevator down to **ECC B4**.



5 When you get off on **B4**, you will see **Starbucks** on your right. **Lee Sam Bong Hall** will be located in front of you. Please refer to **the ECC map** to find the exact location.

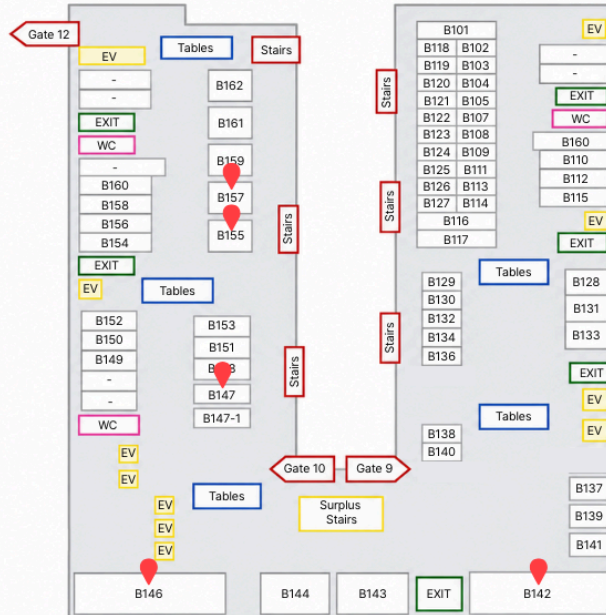

- Floor Map of ECC

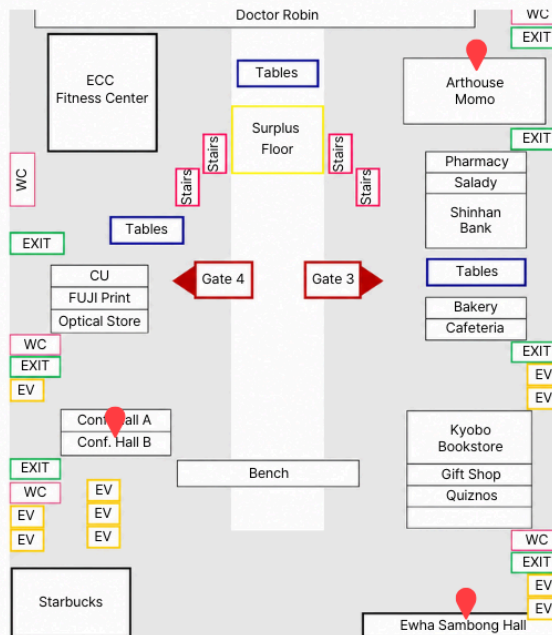
