FAQ: Camp Dues

What do camp dues include?

Accommodation:

Tents, cots, and other shared lodging options.

• Food and Beverages:

- Basic snacks, both alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages, ice.
- o Refrigerators for storage, one communal meal.
- o Drinking water, grills, microwave, kettles, pots, pans, and condiments.

• Camp Amenities:

- Showers, water for showering, evaporation tarp.
- DJ and sound equipment.
- A used bike of assorted style.

• Camp Infrastructure:

- Basic power, lighting, communal structures.
- Shaded areas, tarps, tables, chairs.

• Transportation and Storage:

- Storage and transportation of camp materials to and from the playa.
- Transportation for campers to/from Reno and on/off the playa.

• Art Projects / Theme Installations:

 Projects such as building and decorating the Portal, Speakeasy, and purchasing hotdogs for our camp contributions.

How are camp dues calculated?

 At 17 Virgins, camp dues are calculated based on the "proportional use" of camp amenities. We adjust dues according to each camper's usage of our basic services. For instance, a camper who provides their own transportation, accommodations (e.g., a shiftpod), and power (e.g., a personal generator) will pay less compared to someone who utilizes all camp-provided amenities.

How and when are dues paid?

• Initial Deposit:

 Campers must submit a \$500 deposit by the deadline as provided to secure their spot.

• Expense Submission:

 Campers should submit any approved expenses incurred on behalf of the camp shortly after the Burn concludes.

• Final Calculation:

- After the Burn, the camp will tally all expenses and adjust dues accordingly.
- Each camper's final amount due is calculated by subtracting their initial deposit and any personal expenses submitted, plus deductions for any significant camp resources they provided themselves.
- Campers will be given a deadline and will need to send their dues in a cross pay determined by currency.
