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Queen of Kush	Details
Shanakdakhete	• 170 BCE • First independent women ruler in Kush • Followed Egyptian gods and customs • Economy exploded and borders expanded under her time in power
Amanirenas	• 40-10 BCE • Warrior, blind in one eye, talented negotiator • Fought Roman army, which had captured Egypt so it could feed its huge army • Kept Rome, the world's most powerful army out of Kush • Signed profitable peace treaty with Rome that expanded trade and protected the borders of Kush • Stole statues of Augustus Caesar • Put one statue's head in ground so everyone in Kush would walk on the head of Augustus!
Amanishakheto	• 10 BCE–1 CE • Tomb robbed in 1800's • What's left in tomb proves she was powerful and wealthy

Amanitore	• 1-c. 25 CE • Trade at its height • Great prosperity - wealth • Improved irrigation system so farming flourished • Iron industry flourished
Amantitere	• 25-c. 41 CE • May have been Jewish • Small community of Jews in Meroe • Time of great wealth
Amanikhatashan	• 62-c. 85 CE • Shared Kushite archers to help Roman army fight Jews • Hieroglyphics fell out of favor • Scholars cannot read the cursive writing of Kush
Maleqorobar and Lahideamani	• 266-c. 283 CE) and Lahideamani (r. c. 306-c. 314 CE • Kush started to fall apart due to environmental issues with deforestation and overuse of farmland and attacks • Kush deserted 350 after invasion from Axum Empire (modern day Ethiopia and Eritrea)
