A motion was made, seconded, and carried to approve the August membership meeting minutes.

A motion was made, seconded, and carried to approve the agenda with the addition of the ARRL Section Manager's talk on mutual aid.

Treasurer's report: Two new family memberships and two new individual members paid dues, no other transactions.

Business session

New business/Calendar of events

ARRL club affiliation

- Our club affiliation needs to be renewed.
- For the renewal we need to know how many KE members are ARRL members.

Mutual aid talk

- ARRL section leader Dan Goldstien will give a talk on mutual aid.
- The talk will be recorded and available for viewing later.
- We need to let our ARRL section know what we can provide. If we show up at a disaster unknown our services may not be able to be used.
- ARES operators are classified as level 1, 2, or 3. We should know our own level so we can be used appropriately.

San Jose math festival

- A table for the club would cost \$500.
- Frans KJ6IUV offered our remote radio participation but has heard nothing back.

Antenna/patchbox installation

- A list of required parts has now been made, the cost will be about \$560 per installation. Comments are welcome.
- Canyon Trail Park and Castro Park are the most likely first installation locations.
- A 2M and separate 70cm/GMRS, or possibly 220MHz, antenna and separate coax will be needed because operation on 2M and GMRS cannot be handled by a single operator at the same time.
- A motion was made, seconded, and carried to approve up to \$600 per antenna installation, up to 3 locations.

In person digital mode workshop

- The purpose will be to provide help with fldigi software installation and demo simple examples of fldigi messaging.
- A possible date is Sep. 25 at the KCC.

Old business

Fall SET

- The date for the fall SET is OCT. 8.
- We hope to get participation from members in addition to the usual SET attendees. We could invite EBARC members to participate.
- FRS/GMRS participation is encouraged but a single ham operator shouldn't feel compelled to handle both ham radio communication and FRS/GMRS messages at the same time. One alternative would be for a ham operator to check-out of the ham net for a half hour to handle FRS/GMRS messages.
- The EC City Hall EOC should be open for us for this SET.
- The SET could be a good opportunity to introduce ourselves to the new fire chief.

MOU

- We are still waiting for the new fire chief to sign the MOU.

Grant application

- The grant committee has not yet followed up on preparing a grant proposal for the ARRL grant offerings in September.

Technical/Infrastructure

- Michael AJ6RZ reported using a VNA to test antennas SWR over a range of frequencies.
