Additionally, we will examine the rational and irrational behavior of various policy stakeholders from a micro perspective. Micro-perspective approach is particularly important because policies aim to achieve problem-solving through changes in the behavior of policy targets. Hence, in this class, we will reinterpret various theories and implications in behavioral economics within the context of public policy.
