DRILL TESTS:⁴

DRILL TEST #1: STATIONARY DRILL. DEMONSTRATE THE ABILITY TO PERFORM BASIC STATIONARY MOVEMENTS.

DRILL TEST #2: RIFLE DRILL. DEMONSTRATE THE BASIC SKILLS AND UNDERSTANDING OF RIFLE DRILL.

DRILL TEST #3: SQUAD DRILL INSTRUCTOR. LEAD A SQUAD OF CADETS THROUGH A STANDARD SERIES OF DRILL MOVEMENTS.

DEMONSTRATE AN ACCEPTABLE COMMAND VOICE AND MILITARY BEARING.

FOLLOW THE ORDER OF THE MOVEMENTS, KEEP THE SQUAD IN STEP, AVOID OBSTACLES, AND GIVE COMMANDS ON THE PROPER FOOT.

DEMONSTRATE THE ABILITY TO TEACH STATIONARY DRILL, RIFLE DRILL, AND SQUAD DRILL TO JUNIOR CADETS.

DRILL TEST #4: SWORD MANUAL. DEMONSTRATE THE ABILITY TO PERFORM THE SWORD MANUAL AS SHOWN IN THE CADET FIELD MANUAL (CFM).

DRILL TEST #5: PLATOON DRILL. PREPARE A PLATOON FOR INSPECTION WHILE SHOWING ACCEPTABLE MILITARY BEARING AND KNOWLEDGE.

DRILL A PLATOON OF CADETS THROUGH A STANDARD SERIES OF MOVEMENTS INCLUDING COLUMNS AND FLANKS.

DRILL TEST #6: PLATOON DRILL INSTRUCTOR. DEMONSTRATE THE ABILITY TO TEACH SQUAD DRILL, PLATOON DRILL, AND SWORD MANUAL TO JUNIOR CADETS.

NOTES:

1. CONDUCT REQUIREMENTS ARE BASED ON NJROTC CLASS CONDUCT AND SCHOOL CONDUCT (BOTH IN CLASS AND OUT OF CLASS).

2. BASED ON UNIFORM INSPECTION SCORES OR AS DETERMINED BY THE SNSI OR NSI.

3. SRHS SPORTS ATHLETES RECEIVE A CREDIT OF 5 HOURS PER SPORTS SEASON. HOURS ARE GRANTED UPON COMPLETION OF THE SEASON.

4. DRILL PRACTICAL EXAMS SHALL BE ADMINISTERED BY THE SNSI, NSI, OR SPECIFICALLY AUTHORIZED CADET STAFF MEMBERS.
