 - i. Hannah Wolfe-MacPike accepted our job offer and will tentatively be arriving in Homer and beginning work April 27th. Hannah was previously the Collections Manager at the Kodiak History Museum for over 2 years. She is a lifelong Alaskan, raised in Sitka. Other professional experience includes work as an Interpretive Park Ranger for Sitka National Historical Park as well as with The Friends of Sheldon Jackson Museum.
 - ii. Side conversation on Shorebird Festival participation, noting that Hannah will shadow Whitney during the May 6-10 event so that she can learn about that process
 - c. HVAC updates
 - i. HVAC has been Short-cycling with the cold, electricians have been in and notes that there are some sensor issues, but have to have a system that will tell the HVAC to regulate the humidity
 - ii. Request for bids is out for reviewing the system, being circulated via email to potential parties
 - d. Resolution No. 26.01 to approve withdrawal of \$75,000 from Global CD to contribute towards HVAC refurbishment expenses (into an account at FNBA)
