General Messaging Guidance on Texas' S.B. 8:

Do NOT compare to "Handmaid's Tale"

When discussing patients traveling out of state to receive care, do NOT use phrases related to "underground railroad" to conflate this to the efforts in rejecting and ending slavery

Do NOT use xenophobic, Islamophobic language like "Texas Taliban"

DO speak to providers, storytellers, clinic admin, and abortion funds in Texas

DO guide calls to action to supporting Texas abortion funds and independent providers, directly
