

# 2025 / 2026 School Supply List

Farmington Public School District provides your child with all books, supplies, and materials necessary for the completion of their grade level. Parents and students are always welcome to voluntarily provide additional supplies. Voluntarily providing supplies helps your student and helps the school.

A few important reminders... Labeling:

When possible, it is very important that supplies are clearly labeled with a student's name. Many classrooms use specific procedures when labeling folders, notebooks and binders. Please do not label these items until teachers provide specific instructions.

#### Backpacks:

Also, when purchasing a backpack for school, please DO NOT purchase packs with wheels. Rolling backpacks do not fit well in our lockers and can hamper children during arrival and dismissal.

## Gym Shoes:

All students are asked to bring a pair of "clean" athletic shoes for use during gym. These shoes should be left at school, so that each student always has appropriate footwear for physical education classes.

At the start of the school year, additional items may be suggested by your classroom teacher. Please do not spend an excessive amount of money on school supplies, the basics will work just fine.

- 1 pair of children's Fiskars scissors (not labeled)
- 2 packages of pencils (sharpened, DixonTiconderoga brand is preferred, not labeled)
- 2 packages of Crayola markers one skinny set, one thick set (not labeled)
- 1 6 pack of skinny Expo dry erase markers (not labeled)
- 1 plain plastic double pocket folder (labeled no characters)
- 1 pair of children's headphones (no ear buds) for personal use on computers (labeled)

### 1st Grade:

- · Tennis shoes to be left at school for physical education class
- Headphones (no ear buds) (labeled) to be left at school
- 1 pair of child scissors
- · Change of clothes (labeled and in a zip-lock bag) for locker

- 8 pack basic markers (classic colors)
- Crayons (no more than 48)

- 1 Ruler (inches and centimeters)
- 1 Red PLASTIC double pocket folder
- 1 blue PLASTIC double pocket folder
- Small, individual pencil sharpener with disposal box
- 2-3 black dry erase markers
- 2 composition books (wide ruled)
- 1" (3 ring) binder, white, clear cover with pockets
- 3 ring dividers (1 pack of 5)
- Scissors (Fiskars)
- Highlighter
- 2 Hi-Polymer erasers
- · 2 boxes of tissue
- 1 Pair of headphones or earbuds to use with computers
- · Gym shoes to be left at school for gym class
- 1 container of disinfecting wipes (Lysol, Clorox, etc)

### 3rd Grade:

- (2) 1 subject notebook (wide-ruled, and any color)
- 1 pair of earbuds or headphones to use with computers (make sure they fit)
- 1 pair of tennis shoes w/name to be left at school for gym class
- 1 large pencil pouch, but small enough to fit in desk
- · A few sharpened pencils
- 1-2 glue sticks
- 1 set of thin or thick Crayola Markers
- 1 set of colored pencils
- · 4 or more different colored highlighters
- 2 different colored pens
- Pair of scissors (Fiskars work great)
- 2-3 Expo Markers and an eraser or an old clean sock
- 1 set 3x3 post-it notes
- · Individualized pencil sharpener
