### **Homework**

**ALL ASSIGNMENTS ARE POSTED ON GOOGLE CLASSROOM.**

Generally, homework is assigned every night and is due at the beginning of class the following day unless specifically noted otherwise. A zero will be given for 1) assignment not completed on time; 2) not including the work; 3) less than  $\frac{2}{3}$  complete. A checkmark (✓) in Genesis indicates that grading is based on completion of the assignment (as opposed to accuracy). Since all homework assignments are reviewed in class and/or posted on Google Classroom, late assignments will not be accepted for credit without prior approval and arrangements with the exception of illness. Individual arrangements will be made for an extended illness.

### **Assessments**

Tests and Quizzes are always announced in advance. In addition, other assignments, such as projects, may be given that will be worth the equivalent of a test or quiz grade. Arrangements for missed assessments will be made on an individual basis.

### **Khan Academy**

Khan Academy assignments usually consist of 4-7 questions and may be graded as the actual score or as a completion grade. Students may do the assignment as often as they would like to get the grade they want. If they need help, they may contact me and we can arrange a time so that I can help them get that grade.

### **DeltaMath**

DeltaMath assignments may be graded as the actual score or as a completion grade. If the score will count as the grade, a document showing what skills, the number of required correct answers, and the number of allowed attempts is attached to the Google Classroom Post. Completion assignments usually allow students an unlimited number of attempts for correct answers. Students may do the assignment as often as they would like to get the grade they want. If they need help, they may contact me and we can arrange a time so that I can help them get that grade.

### **Other Assignments and Assessments**

Some assignments may be graded based on completion (usually entered in Genesis in terms of a check mark) or alternative assessment. Examples of these would be assignments using online platforms (Formative, DeltaMath, etc.). Students will know prior to the assignment whether it will be entered into Genesis as an actual grade or completion. Checks on assignments translate to the following:

✓ ++ = 110% The student has gone above and beyond the expectations in some way.

✓ + = 100% The assignment has been fully completed and was on time.

✓ = 75% The assignment was not fully completed or may have been done late without prior arrangements.

✓ - = 65% The assignment was incomplete and/or late (with prior arrangement), but has still earned a passing grade.

✓ - - = 0 The assignment was not done, was less than two-thirds complete, or was turned in late without having made PRIOR arrangements to do so.
