Exam Format

Online proctored exam delivered through Kryterion.

- Content: Approximately 60 multiple-choice and multi-select questions
- Time allotted to complete the exam: 120 minutes
- Passing score: 70%





 Certificate Validity Period: this certificate is valid for 2 years. To renew your certificate, you must meet our continuing education requirements described here.

Registration fee is **USD** \$300, plus applicable taxes as required per local law, which includes one (1) free retake if required. If you need to reschedule your exam for any reason, please provide at least 72 hours notice to avoid additional fees.

Sample Question & Practice Exam

The exam is all multiple choice, and some questions are multi-select. Multi-select questions have more than one correct answer and you need to identify all of them, as with the example below.

Data can be loaded to a custom object in which of the following ways? Select all that apply.

- a. Manually by importing a 1MB or smaller CSV file
- b. Using Bulk API Connector to load a CSV
- c. Using Rules Engine to load from another object or S3
- d. Push data directly from a data warehouse to MDA
- e. Using a pre-built Connector such as Mixpanel, Survey Monkey, or Salesforce

Optionally, you may <u>register</u> for the Level 3 **Practice** exam which is free and unproctored, to familiarize yourself with the item format and the approximate level of difficulty of the real exam.

Taking a Proctored Exam

This exam is proctored to ensure test security and to confirm the test taker's identity. While there are <u>testing centers</u>, most people take the exam online. If you've never taken an online proctored exam before, there are several things you should know.

- You must register for an exam date and time in advance. Although you may find an
 available time slot on the same day that you're registering, we strongly recommend
 that you give yourself at least 1 hour to complete your <u>biometric profile</u> and install
 Respondus Secure Browser software, before the exam time starts.
- As part of your biometric profile, you must take a photo of yourself with your computer. When you launch the exam, you will be asked to take another photo, and the two must match. Make sure you sit close to the camera with adequate lighting.
- Your keyboard is blocked from being used during the exam, and you cannot open other applications.
- You must sit in the camera's view at all times, and avoid reading/talking out loud.
- External monitors are not allowed; the exam will only display on your laptop screen.
- If you don't feel ready, you're welcome to reschedule and push out your exam without penalty as long as you provide 72 hours notice. You can reschedule through the <u>Webassessor</u> portal, or access support chat in the lower right corner of this <u>page</u>.
