SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY AND AUDITION REQUIREMENTS

Hawai'i Thespians Scholarship*

In order to be eligible for this award, the student must:

- be a current high school senior
- have a minimum GPA of 2.5
- intend to major or minor in a performing art (including but not limited to Theatre, Musical Theatre, Technical Theatre, Dance, Film, Vocal Performance, etc.) at an accredited two-year or four-year institution of higher learning (not an online program)
- be a current Thespian, registered with the Educational Theatre Association
- be an active member of his or her school's Theatre program, as verified by the school's Theatre teacher or director

In order to be considered for this scholarship, students must:

- attend the 2026 Hawaii Thespians Festival (\$15.00 registration fee)
- submit the Scholarship Application Form (which includes verification of current GPA and teacher recommendation) AND a one-page résumé
- present either two contrasting monologues OR one monologue and one musical theatre song OR present a portfolio of Technical Theatre work
- If singing, the student must bring his/her own music track, on a CD or mp3 , without vocals or sing *a capella*.

Hawai'i Conservatory of Performing Arts Scholarship*

In order to be eligible for this award, the student must:

- be a current high school sophomore, junior or senior.
- apply to and be accepted by the Windward Community College
- intend to pursue an Associate degree with a concentration in Theatre at Windward Community College

In order to be considered for this scholarship, students must:

- attend the 2026 Hawai'i Thespians Festival (\$15.00 registration fee)
- submit the Scholarship Application Form (which includes verification of current GPA and teacher recommendation)
- present two **contrasting** monologues

University of Northern Colorado B.F.A. in Musical Theatre Program**

In order to be eligible for this award, the student must:

- be a current high school senior
- intend to major in musical theatre at the University of Northern Colorado

In order to be considered for this opportunity, students must:

- attend the 2026 Hawai'i Thespians Festival (\$15.00 registration fee)
- submit the Auditions Application Form (which includes verification of current GPA and teacher recommendation) AND a one-page résumé
- present two **contrasting** songs and one monologue

**Scholarship requirements are as of November 2025 and may be subject to change.*

***Students who audition for the University of Northern Colorado may be offered a spot in the program. If given an offer, the students are still required to apply to UNC and pay tuition and fees as billed.*

**** Performing three pieces is only required for the UNC spot.*
