SGMS Chromebook Agreement

2025 - 2026

Each student at Shady Grove Middle School will be issued a touchscreen Chromebook and charger for the duration of their time at SGMS. This agreement provides students and their parents/guardians with information regarding MCPS and SGMS Chromebook and technology policies.

Ownership of the Chromebook:

- The chromebook has been LOANED to the student by SGMS for educational purposes. The chromebook is the property of MCPS.
- MCPS staff can take and/or inspect any chromebook at any time, including via electronic remote access.
- Computer Usage at Shady Grove MS is a privilege not a right

Handling of the Chromebook: Students are solely responsible for the Chromebooks issued to them. The student:

- 1. MUST bring their Chromebook (fully charged) to school each day.
- 2. MUST keep their Chromebook in a secured location or in their possession at all times.
- 3. MUST treat the device with care, never handling it inappropriately or in such a way that could cause possible damage. Students will carry the device in the padded bag that has been provided to them.
- 4. WILL NOT remove or interfere with the Chromebook serial number and barcode tags, individual name tags, or remove the name tag on their charger.
- 5. WILL NOT scratch/carve, or draw on/decorate the chromebook with anything permanent. 8th graders will remove all stickers at the end of the year
- 6. May NOT swap or share their assigned Chromebooks (or passwords) with other students.

Usage of the Chromebook: When using the loaned chromebook, students:

- MUST comply all MCPS policies including the Chromebook Agreement & MCPS Acceptable Use Policy
- 2. WILL use the device for educational purposes only This means they are to be used only for assignments given to you by teachers.
- 3. WILL communicate with all staff and students in a respectful and appropriate manner, being mindful of digital citizenship.
- 4. WILL follow all rules concerning copyright and plagiarism. This includes but is not limited to downloading, posting, sharing illegally obtained content, or using AI tools to complete your assignments.
- 5. WILL NOT attempt to bypass or disable filtering or other technology protection measures put in place by MCPS
- 6. WILL NOT attempt to install or run any operating system other than the Chrome OS from MCPS.

Damaged, Lost or Missing Chromebooks: If a chromebook is damaged or lost, Students:

- 1. WILL report the damage or loss immediately to the media center
- 2. MAY NOT choose to keep a broken device
- 3. WILL pay the fines/obligations for the repairs/replacement if damaged or permanently lost
- 4. <u>WILL NOT receive another assigned chromebook until the obligations have been paid and must complete all assignments on paper until then</u>

The cost to repair ANY damage to the chromebook, intentional or accidental, is the responsibility of the student.

Breakage due to normal wear and tear does not result in a fine. The following is the list of charges:

- \$25 Missing keys, peeling trackpad, minor case damage, broken camera, missing or broken charger
- \$50 Moderate case damage, or multiple \$25 damages
- \$75 Damaged touchscreen, major case damage or multiple \$25 & \$50 damages
- \$300 Replacement due to irreparable damage or destruction, including fluid damage, loss or theft, multiple \$25, \$50 & \$75 damages
