The UN's 2018 IPCC Report states that we have [12 Years](#) to avert the Climate Crisis. 12 Years to prevent ecological catastrophe and human suffering on a massive scale. We have known about this crisis and have endured its early effects for decades while politicians have turned a blind eye. Now for *the first time* a solution has been proposed at the scope and scale necessary to address this Crisis in a just and equitable way. The Green New Deal represents a transformation in the politics of climate change.

We have the technology, resources, and popular support. Now we need the moral courage and political will to pass the Green New Deal and transition our economy to 100% renewable energy by 2030, and advance racial and economic justice in the process.

As outlined in the resolution, the committee will generate a detailed plan to:

- Decarbonize our economy within 10 years
- Create a jobs guarantee program that includes local and national unions in the process of worker training and deployment
- Mandate that economically, racially, and geographically marginalized communities are prioritized for investment and inclusion in the transition
- Introduce the detailed action plan by January 1st of 2020, setting the groundwork for legislation that will be passed once Donald Trump is no longer the president.
