PRIVACY NOTICE

SLCC is a Community Interest Company, meaning any profits are put back into the club. We provide athletic training for cheerleading in recreational and competitive teams.

This privacy notice provides you with the necessary information regarding your rights and our obligations, and explains how, why, and when we process your personal data.

SLCC collect and use your personal information to help support you, improve the services we provide, to help us fundraise more efficiently and to help understand the demographics of our athletes to ensure we remain inclusive and forward thinking as a club.

We will only ask you for the information that we need and will process personal data on the basis of consent. We will always explain to you why we are need the information and we will handle and store your personal information in line with data protection and GDPR regulations.

The type of information we may request may include but is not limited to:

- > Name and contact details
- > Date of birth
- > Next of Kin (where relevant)
- > Athlete's details
- > Details of other professionals involved
- > Health information (where relevant)
- ➤ Support needs

Special Categories Data: We sometimes need to process sensitive personal information (known as Special Category Data) about you, to ensure we are providing our services to a wide range of people (Equalities Data) or health/medical information about you that is important for us to know to help to support you. Certain types of sensitive personal data are subject to additional protection under Article 9 of the GDPR.

It is important that you understand your legal rights around your personal data and how we may use it.

Sharing your Personal Data: SLCC will never disclose or share your personal information without your consent, other than for the purposes specified in this notice or where there is a legal requirement.

SLCC takes every reasonable step to protect and secure your personal data. We use a combination of organisational and technological security measures to protect your personal information to the highest possible standards. All staff who have access to personal data are given training to make sure that they always understand the importance of keeping your information safe and secure.
