- Move 'add' pane to main talk editor window (as suggested by UI team)
 - Include Description and Level fields to 'Talk Details' area
 - A new 'Add new talk' button would add an empty row to the bottom of the talk list, select it, and allow input from the 'Talk Details' area
- Add Import / Export buttons
 - Import popup screen (Select RSS/CSV)

- Export button functionality (needs to be connected)
- User feedback for error messages (popups)
 - An invalid CSV file path outputs to the console, but doesn't give feedback to the user

- Add 'Export' button (Export to CSV) is hidden in file menu
- Fix 'Level' column
 - Rename to Skill Level
 - Change to dropdown menu for Beginner/Intermediate/Advanced
- Fix 'Clear' button
 - Change 'Clear' to 'Remove all' in translations
 - Find new image for Clear/Remove all (not a backspace image)
- Add checkboxes to select more than one talk
 - This would allow a user to remove multiple talks at a time
 - The 'Talk details' area of the window would be disabled (Unless editing multiple talks at a time is allowed. I.e. changing the room of several talks at once)
- Remove ID, keep row number
 - The list of talks uses a row number and an ID, which are both visible to the user, but there is no clear reason for the user to have both. The ID seems to just appear, but can be altered, thus it is hard for the user to understand its point. Is the ID even necessary? ID removed
 - Add a 'move talk up' / 'move talk down' button to increment / decrement the ID number and move the talk's position in the table by 1
- Add search functionality from dropdown lists
 - This is included in one of the mockups from the UX team, but absent in the other.
