Timeline for Elections 2022 – Jerusalem Press Club

As Israel is getting ready for another rounds of elections, the fifth in three years, the Jerusalem Press Club is happy to provide you with material and information that may be helpful for your coverage.

Key dates for this process are listed below for your convenience.

August

- 📅 August 9th - The Labor Party Primary Elections for the list's candidates.
- 📅 August 10th - The Likud Party Primary Elections for the list's candidates.
- 📅 August 23rd - The Meretz Party Primary Elections for the list's candidates and leader.
- 📅 August 23rd - The Religious Zionism Party Primary Elections for the list's candidates.
- 📅 August 30th - Deadline to enlist parties with the Central Elections Committee.

September

- 📅 September 11th - List of registered voters is published.
- 📅 September 15th - Deadline to submit parties' candidates lists to the Central Elections Committee.

October

- October 18th - Beginning of election advertising on television & radio.
- 📅 October 20th - Diplomats and sailors cast their votes abroad.
- 📅 October 28th – Publication of the final public opinion polls.

November

2022 ISRAEL VOTES



- 📅 November 1st - Election Day. Exit polls at 22:00. More accurate (but not final) results expected overnight.
- 📅 President Herzog begins consultations with party leaders after publication of the election's results, and has a week to give the mandate to the candidate most likely to form a coalition. Once tasked by the president, that candidate has 28 days to form a government and can request another 14 days if necessary. If he fails, the President can pass the mandate to a different candidate.
